

WILLYS-OVERLAND VOLUME GROWING

Not Only in This Country
But in Europe As Well,
Demand Increases

TOLEDO, O., Nov. 24.—The Willys-Overland Company reports net profits of \$2,557,292.21 for the nine months of the current year ending September 30, after all charges but before Federal taxes, indicating that the 1928 business volume of the company as well as its earnings for the year will establish a new high record.

The nine months earnings compare with \$7,306,184 for the same period of 1927, an increase of \$1,251,215.21 for the first nine months of 1928.

Throughout the current year the Willys-Overland has set new monthly sales and production records and is now nearing the end of the greatest year in the entire history of the company with an indicated output of 225,000 Whippets and

Willys-Knights. Not alone has the Toledo manufacturer of Whippet fours and sixes and Willys-Knight sixes shown a record breaking domestic business for 1928 but the remarkable growth of the company's business in the foreign markets of the world and the wide public acceptance of the Willys-Overland products has been one of the features of the current year's business.

Texaco Products Now Shipped To Oregon On Sea

Supplies of gasoline, kerosene, motor oils, fuel oil and other Texaco products, destined for distribution throughout the Oregon territory, have just been unloaded at The Texas company's new \$1,250,000 terminal in Portland by two of the largest and finest tankers in the oil company's fleet, according to announcement by C. L. Compagnie, vice president and sales director.

The S. S. Emma H. Coppage and the S. S. Bolivar docked at the new 600-foot wharf at the concern on the Willamette river, and from them flowed the first flood of Texaco gasoline, motor oils and fuel oil to pass through the five pipelines connecting the wharf with the terminal's twenty-four storage tanks.

With the arrival of the two tankers at the new distribution terminal, announcement was made by William J. Hunker, vice president and assistant manager of the Texas Refining Company of California, subsidiary of the oil company, that Portland has been made a port of call for the Texaco tanker fleet. This fleet constitutes a veritable armada of vessels, traveling constantly between United States ports, from domestic ports to the West Indies and Caribbean; Mexico to United States ports and the West Indies; to Europe, Africa, South America and on charter to other countries.

New Oakland All American Six Is Popular Model

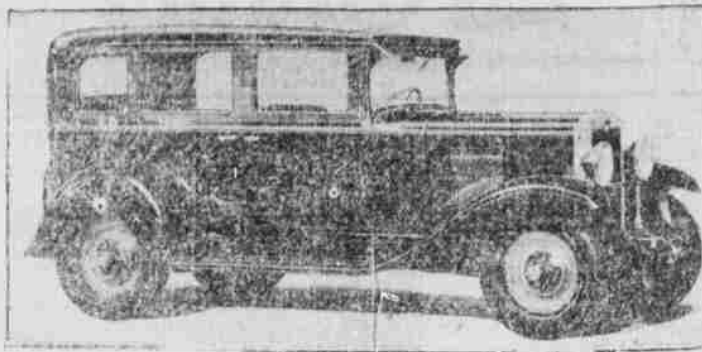

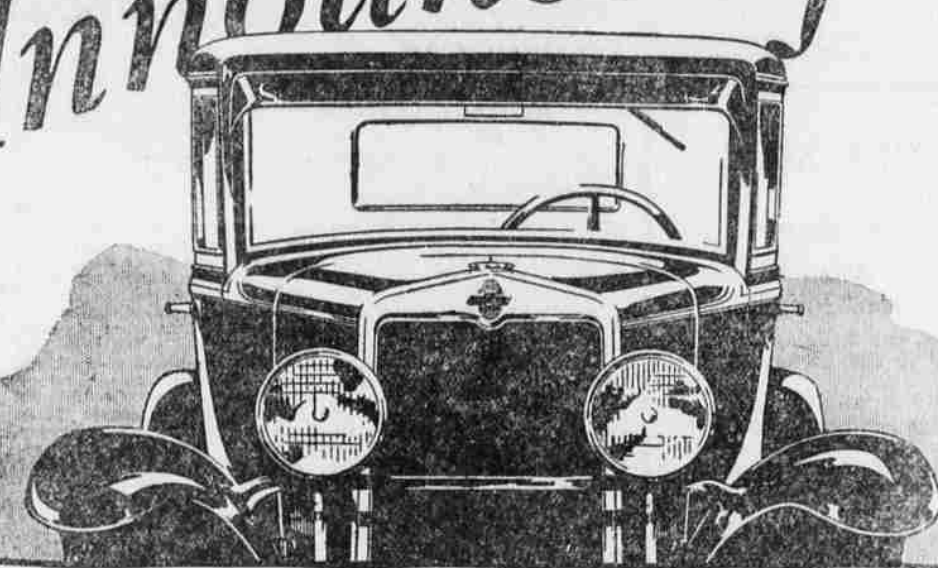
