RAY MILLER STOPS COAST YOUTH IN 7TH

DETROIT, Dec. 1 (AP)—Ray Miller, blonde haired 22-year-old Chicago youth, today is brewing prison for Sammy Mandell, world's lightweight champion.

Miller, heretofore regarded as an in and out in the boxing business, became the foremost contender for Mandell's title, as a result of his smashing victory over Jimmy McLarin, the baby faced puncher from Los Angeles, in their battle in the Olympia arena last night. Miller, a 5 to 1 shot in the betting, scored a surprising triumph when he stopped McLarin, acknowledged king of lightweight sluggers, in the seventh round of their scheduled 10-round battle.

TROJANS, NOTRE DAME PLAY TODAY

Capacity Crowd Packs Coliseum; Westerners Hope to Upset Irish

LOS ANGELES, Dec. 1 (AP)—Southern California and Notre Dame football elevens are meeting here this afternoon in one of the most important inter-sectional games of the day before a capacity crowd.

Men who offered terrific prices for seats at the gates of the sold-out Coliseum, stuck their money in their mouths and turned empty pockets inside-out when the word "hey" was heard. It generally was concluded that the report had spread that it was anybody's game. Promise of a clear day, a hot field, and mild weather only added to the uncertainty of the outcome. Both teams had prepared aerial attacks which might spell disaster for one caught napping, and each had spent hours on defense against such overhanded methods.

The Trojan line, noted for its hard charging, was equalled only by a forward wall of just such aggressiveness from South Bend. Where Southern California listed Williams, Saunders, Thomas and Johnson or Aplet in a crack backfield, the Ramblers countered with Brady, Niemiec, Chevigny and S. Collins whose names also were known throughout the realm of the king of sports.

The results of the previous inter-sectional contests between these teams were: 1926 at Los Angeles, Notre Dame 13, Southern California 12; 1927 at Soldiers Field, Chicago, Notre Dame 7, Southern California 6.

Braddock Defeats Tuffy Griffiths

NEW YORK, Dec. 1 (AP)—James J. Braddock, of Jersey City, N. J., languishing in obscurity for some months, has jumped into prominence as a result of a surprising two-round knockout of Tuffy Griffiths, Sioux City, Ia., light heavyweight sensation, at Madison Square Garden last night.

Nineteen thousand fans came to see Tuffy dispose of his eastern foe in short order. They remained to cheer while the boxer, head, boxing cleverly and punching hard, knocked Griffiths down four times in the second round before referee McPortland halted hostilities and carried the Iowa, unconscious, to his corner.

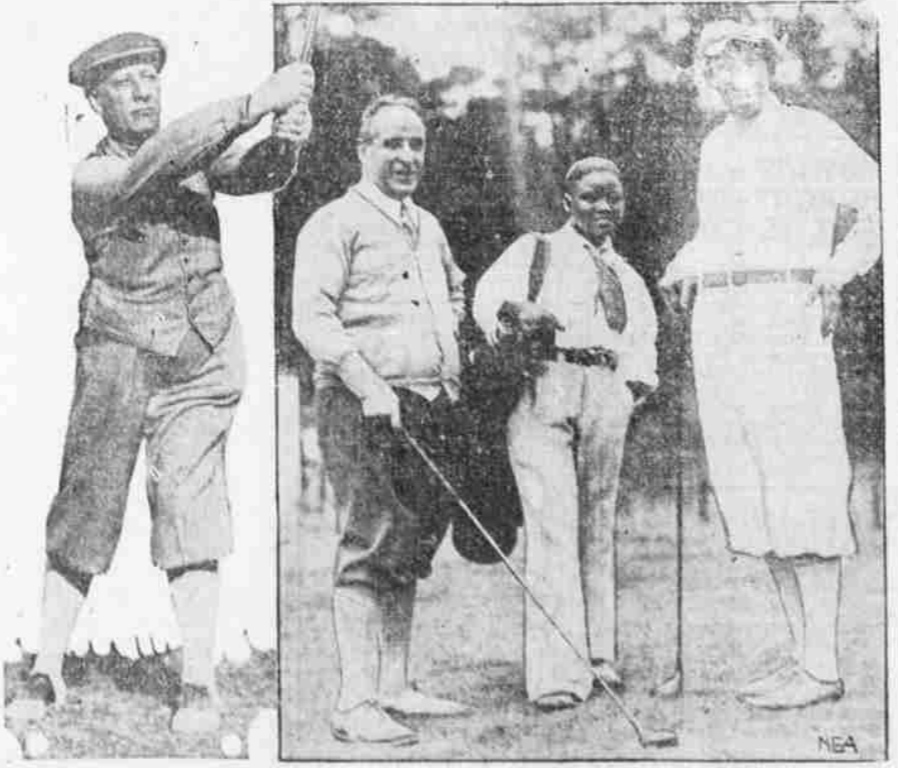
