VALUE DOUBLED
IOWA CITY (AP)—The value of the property of the University of Iowa has doubled in five years, while the enrollment has increased 34 per cent. The university plant in 1923 was worth \$3,410,000, now its value is \$16,000,000. Enrollment figures are 6,347 and 8,502.

Gives Help On Home Heating

Smokes must have free passage from the warm air furnace and the smoke pipe must be short to eliminate formation of creosote when wood or sawdust is used as fuel.

When building a home insist that the contractor put in a large chimney, centrally located, and to be used for the warm air furnace exclusively.

Roof should be cleaned from the furnace regularly and the cleaning doors kept tightly closed. It is difficult to keep a wood fire "banked" unless it is covered with ashes.

Draft may be insufficient because of a tree or other high obstruction near the chimney.

Warm air leader pipes from the furnace should have a pitch of at least 3/8 of an inch in 12 inches.

The check damper should always be closed when the furnace is fired.

Leave the fire door damper open for some time after firing the furnace with soft coal.

If the air in a room contains plenty of moisture it is possible to keep that room comfortable at a lower temperature than if the air is dry.

If the range boiler is heated by the furnace some rattling may be caused by too small pipes or by clogged pipes.

Burning exceedingly wet wood in the furnace is wasteful. It gives less heat per dollar than can be obtained with well-seasoned wood.

It is better to have too much draft for the furnace than not enough. Checking the fire is not difficult.

With soft coal as a fuel it is more economical to fire the furnace five or six times a day. From Northwest Furnace Builders.

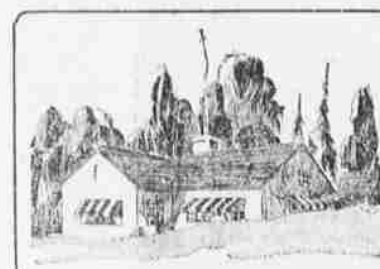
