

NEW CHEVROLET IS SHOWN HERE

Two Coaches and Two Imperial Sedans Arrive at Blue Mountain Garage

Today and tomorrow in La Grande and all over the country are to be red letter days in Chevrolet history.

At the Blue Mountain garage the dealers are prepared to display and demonstrate the new six-cylinder Chevrolet, whose recent announcement created one of the sensations in automobile history.

Shown in Portland Hundreds of thousands of persons have viewed the new Chevrolet six at the advance showing in Portland, but no cars for demonstration purposes were available at that time.

Today is the first opportunity for motorists to ride in the new six and judge for themselves regarding a performance ability which Chevrolet engineers declare sets entirely new standards in the low priced field.

Reservations for demonstrations have been pouring in on Chevrolet dealers by the thousands all over the country and it is certain that a busy time is ahead for the Chevrolet demonstrating fleet that will go into service immediately.

Yet in spite of the fact that the motoring public has not yet ridden in the new six, the appearance of the new Chevrolet and its performance promise given by its specifications have been sufficient to draw thousands of orders from Southern California motorists.

Interest in the performance of the new six cylinder motor is keen among veterans of the automotive trade here as well as among motorists in general.

The manner in which the Chevrolet organization has swung into production on the new six is regarded as a remarkable industrial achievement.

A production estimate for 1929 of 1,250,000 of the new six was given last week by President Motor.

BONDS FOR TEXAS ROADS PROPOSED BY COMMITTEE

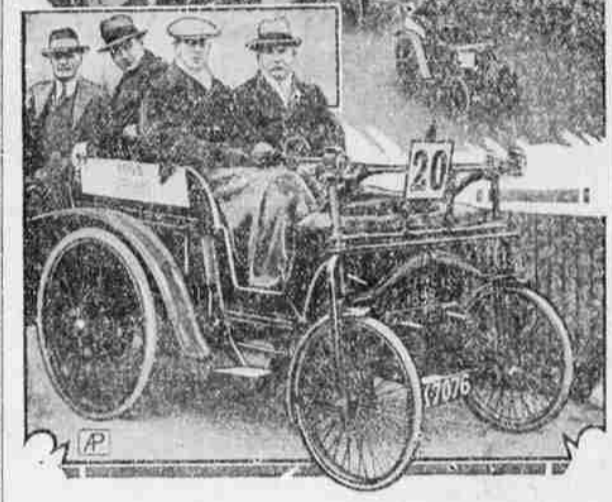

Ancient Cars Roll Over 52-Mile Course in Race Out of London



Motor cars that were the latest thing in transportation when King Edward was head of the British royal family recently emerged to prove their worth in a 52-mile race.

BRIGHTON, Eng. (AP)—Two of the first American automobiles imported into Europe, a Cadillac, built in 1902, and an Oldsmobile of the same year figured prominently in a race from London to Brighton recently.

Starting in age from 25 to 35 years, the majority of these vehicles succeeded in accomplishing the 52 mile course.

Gold medals were awarded to the owners of four automobiles, the performance of which, in the opinion of the judges, were the most meritorious, having regard to the age of the cars, their conformity to original design, and performance on the road as recorded by official observers.

Auto Speed Outstrips Reaction Of Human Brain, Says Segrave
