

### NEW ACCESSORIES ON 1929 MODELS

#### Standard Equipment Provided This Year Make Motorists' Tasks Easier

NEW YORK (AP)—The 1929 crop of automobile accessories, most of which have been included as standard equipment, provides a wide and varied field of devices to aid the motorist. The national automobile shows in January at New York and Chicago find many of these devices on display for the first time.

Chromium plate, used by many manufacturers on their 1928 models, has come into almost universal use on accessories for the 1929 models. Radiator caps, which lock and are almost as flat as the engine hood, are chromium plated, and even some of the internal fittings, such as ash receivers which eliminate fuming from cigarette butts, vanity and rear view mirrors and clocks are finished in the new non-tarnishing metal.

Hydraulically operated jacks that lift the heaviest automobiles with a featherweight touch on the handle; windshield cleaners that clear the whole shield and are electrically heated to be effective in sleet are among the newer aids for the motorist on display at the shows.

Heaters operated by hot air from the engine or by steam generated by exhaust heat and by vapor will keep car occupants comfortable in bitterly cold weather.

Vacuum cleaners that remove the last vestige of dust from tufted upholstery; radiator protecting shutters in which the vanes are vertical in keeping with the modern style, and such novelties as freeze testers which determine the protection afforded by anti-freeze mixtures will be on display.

For the owner who stores his car in an unheated garage several electrically operated heaters have been devised. In one of them a tiny coil of heater wire fits into one of the radiator hoses and is connected to any house-lighting socket, keeping the cooling water always warm.

Fenders, which get bumped and scraped in traffic, can be repaired with facility and little expense through the use of hand operated spray painting equipment. The amateur can do a touch-up job that compares favorably with the work of the painting expert through the new device.

Many of the specialties designed to make driving easier, more comfortable and safer are even too new to become standard equipment on 1929 models, but probably will be included later. The movement within the industry toward making all necessary accessories standard equipment included in the factory price is even more pronounced in the 1929 models than in previous years.

### Spend \$600,000 On Grading Road In Lane County

PORTLAND, Ore., Jan. 5 (AP)—Decision to spend \$600,000 on grading 18 miles of highway between Rain Rock and Florence on the Huslaw highway, in Lane county, was reached here at a conference between the state highway commission and officers of the federal road and forest bureaus.

Half of this sum will be spent this year, the remainder in 1930. The government will give \$25,000 each towards surfacing the Canyon City-Burns and Heppner-Spray highways.

Work of widening the road leading to the Oregon Caves, near Grants Pass, will be hurried this summer, \$20,000 to be spent by the state, \$10,000 by the federal government.

For surfacing six miles of the Salmon river highway the government will allow \$75,000, for surfacing 13.5 miles of the Wapinitia highway, the federal government will grant \$137,000.

It was decided that the state will spend all the money needed for the La Pine-Fort Rock section of the Fremont highway, in order to use on other projects the government money that might go there.

The mount Hood loop will be widened to 30 feet this year between Laurel Hill and the Wapinitia highway. This improvement will cost \$52,000, the federal government to spend \$20,000 on the project.

### Whippet Demand Assures Record In Production

TOLEDO, O., Jan. 5.—With output of the newly designed Whippet fours and sixes steadily stepping into high production at the Willys-Overland plants and trainload after trainload of the striking new models leaving the factory at all hours, every indication now points to the speediest filling of retail orders on new models in the history of the company.

Plans had been well laid for the Toledo company to reach a daily car building schedule beyond all marks ever before accomplished in a short period of time. These plans have been under development for the past year and all of the vast manufacturing facilities of Willys-Overland were keyed up for the anticipated buying demand which followed the introduction of the new Whippet four and six cylinder models which made their bow to the public two weeks ago.

The introduction of the new car has been responsible for a buying demand on the part of the public that overshadows even the great demand which immediately followed the drastic Whippet price cuts in December of last year and continued through the following twelve months.

Commenting on the remarkable reception for the new Whippets that would set a new high mark for Willys-Overland, Mr. John N. Willys said: "The most optimistic of our organization hardly expected such a reception."

### Ford Sales For 39 States Show Largest Totals

Automobile registrations for the month of October covering forty-eight states and the District of Columbia reveal the fact that deliveries of Ford Model A cars led all others in thirty-nine states.

### Unusual Design Of Combustion Chambers Aids

One of the most important factors contributing to the power development of the new Chrysler Imperial engine is the design and shape of its combustion chambers, points out L. W. This breaks up the gas vapors into smaller particles, permitting more efficient burning, higher compression and less carbon accumulation than with other types of combustion chamber construction.

It is the unusual design of these combustion chambers that has made possible the high compression as developed with the new Chrysler "Silver Dome" for use with any standard fuel, continues Mr. Weeks. Because there are fuel vapors which give still greater power at higher compressions, Chrysler engineers have provided the "Red Head" as optional equipment at slight extra cost for all body styles of the Imperial, he adds, giving this extra power to those who may desire it.
