SECOND AUTOPSY ORDERED TODAY

Officers Hold Action Necessary Before Mrs. Ruth Is Buried

WATERDOWN, Mass., Jan. 15 (AP)—An autopsy was necessary today before the body of Mrs. George Norman Ruth, estranged wife of Babe Ruth, could be taken to its last resting place.

Mrs. Ruth died last Friday night in a fire at the home of Dr. Edward H. Kinder, dentist. She had been known to neighbors as Mrs. Helen Kinder and authorities started an investigation into the circumstances of her death when it was learned that she was Mrs. Ruth. That was shortly before the hour which had been set for the funeral. District Attorney Robert T. Bushnell ordered a second autopsy to be performed today on Mrs. Ruth's body, although he said that he was convinced that Mrs. Ruth died from suffocation and incineration, as Medical Examiner George L. West of Middlesex county had reported after a first autopsy. District Attorney Bushnell said Dr. George A. Magrath, medical examiner of Suffolk county, would make the autopsy today because he had equipment better adapted to a chemical analysis of the stomach than had Dr. West.

Dr. Kinder Questioned

Dr. Kinder, who had been in hiding since early Saturday, reported to the Watertown police of his own second yesterday and submitted to four hours questioning. Chief of Police John P. Milmore announced that Dr. Kinder had satisfactorily explained his connections with Mrs. Ruth and with the circumstances of her death. The case was closed so far as the Watertown police were concerned.

Dr. Kinder told Chief Milmore, that he had lived with Mrs. Ruth at intervals since 1927; that he had never married her; that Ruth knew where his wife was.

Ruth's Comment

Ruth's only comment on the case was: "Please let my wife alone. Let her stay dead. I'm in a terrible fix."

Ruth's attorney, John R. Feeney, said the Babe would attend his wife's funeral, which probably will be held tomorrow from the home of the Woodfords. Mrs. Ruth's family in South Boston.

Michael Woodford, Mrs. Ruth's brother, said his family was making arrangements to take care of nine-year-old Dorothy Ruth, who is at school in Wellesley.

JANUARY IS BEST FOR SKY-GAZERS

URBANA, Ill. (AP)—The brightest constellations in the whole sky are displayed above the eastern horizon in the early evening in January. They are the winter constellations, so-called because they are visible throughout the winter nights, rising in the east in the early evening, southing at midnight and sinking in the west at dawn.

Orion is most brilliant of all the constellations and, next to the Big Dipper, the best known. It has the form of a rectangle with three stars in line in the middle, the Belt of Orion which points downward to Sirius and upward to the V-shaped head of Taurus.

Belgeuse Seen

The great red star in the corner of the rectangle farthest to the left is Belgeuse. It is a giant star, having a diameter of 250,000,000 miles. Yet the most powerful telescope shows it only as a point of light, so great is its distance from us.

Sirius, the Dog Star, came into view at 7 o'clock in the evening on the first of the month. It is a white star and the brightest of the stars. But when it is not far above the horizon on a clear, frosty night it flashes rapidly all the colors of the rainbow in succession.

The Little Dog Star, Procyon, is to the left of Sirius and slightly higher. One cannot fail to find this bright star, for it forms an equilateral triangle with Belgeuse and Sirius. Above Procyon is the rectangle of Gemini, the Heavenly Twins, which contains the twin stars, Castor and Pollux.

Still higher is the five-sided figure of Auriga, with the great yellow star Capella in its upper left corner. Capella has the same color as our sun, but it is a larger body than the sun and would appear fifty times brighter if they were both at the same distance.

The star in the lower right corner of Auriga really belongs to Taurus; it is the tip of his upper horn. The head of the Bull is marked by a conspicuous V of stars, with the red Aldebaran as his fiery eye. Above in his shoulder are the familiar Pleiades, or Seven Sisters.

Half Visible

Of the fifteen brightest stars in the heavens one-half are in this small area of the sky. It is as though nature had tried to make amends for the feeble winter sun by decorating the night skies more attractively than at any other season.

As an added attraction the planet Mars now appears near the tips of the horns of Taurus. It is distinguished from the stars by its more vivid red color and its steady light. Mars is now receding from the earth and becoming fainter, but during January it will still remain one of the brightest objects in this part of the sky.
