## Two Negroes Admit Killing Aged Man

LINDEN, Ala., Jan. 22 (AP)—Jack Brown and Edgar Harris, negroes of Birmingham, today were under arrest following their confessions to authorities shortly before midnight last night that they had killed J. H. Moss, 77-year-old postmaster and store-keeper of Hugo, Ala., to death Friday night. Moss' mutilated body was discovered Saturday morning when a patron called at the post office for mail.

Harris hit the aged man on the head, falling him to the floor, according to the confession. Both negroes then obtained a hatchet and an axe and hacked the postmaster to death. The store was ransacked.

## London Institution

Nancy Carroll merely moved the calendar back three years to play the role of a young girl seeking fame and fortune on Broadway in "Manhattan Cocktail," the Paramount story of stage life in which she is co-staged with Richard Arlen, now at the Star theater.

While attending high school she and one of her sisters sought to gain a foothold on the ladder of theatrical fame with a sister act in an amateur night performance at a Tenth avenue combination motion picture and vaudeville theater.

Just before the amateur performance Nancy and her sister confessed they could not comply with the West side residence rule, they they were from the East side, but they were allowed to compete anyway and they won.

A year later, Miss Carroll obtained a place in the chorus of "The Passing Show of 1923," and remained with the company following an earnest parental debate on the subject. "Topics of 1923" was her next show. Hollywood stage production of "Chicago" was the little red headed, blue-eyed Irish girl's first real break. It brought her screen tests by various studios and eventually a secondary lead.

There was a long gap between this picture and Nancy's next. How much longer the little New Yorker would have stuck it out in Hollywood it is difficult to say, but the problem was solved permanently when Anne Nichols, author of the stage and screen success, "Able, My Sister," picked Nancy for the title role in the screen version of her play.

## VIGOROUS BODIES NEED VEGETABLES

### Sugar Works Wonders in Flavoring Them

"What do these canned tomatoes need to make them taste better? Sugar added to the tomatoes while they are being heated will work wonders in making them enjoyable. Sometimes as much sugar as two tablespoonsful to a quart is needed.

"What's wrong with these peas? They taste flat." Add a teaspoonful of sugar to a can of peas while you are warming them and notice the difference.

"What's the matter with these carrots? They don't taste like carrots." Add a teaspoonful of sugar to the carrots while they are cooking and notice the difference.

"This corn is almost tasteless." Add a teaspoonful of sugar to a can of stewed corn when warming it and notice the improvement. Everyone improves the flavor of canned corn by adding butter, salt and pepper. Up to a teaspoonful of sugar per can will give an even greater improvement.

Add a dash of sugar to the cooking of string beans.

It isn't strange that sugar improves all these vegetables. Nature developed sweetness as the perfect flavor and the result is the proper amount of sugar changes flat, unpalatable foods into dishes that can be enjoyed.

OSSENING, N. Y., Jan. 22 (AP)—Frank Hawkes, long term prisoner who with two others escaped from Sing Sing prison last night was recaptured today at Phillips Manor, two and a half miles from the prison.

The capture of Hawkes left only one of the escaped convicts at large. He is George Price, 25, of New York, serving 20 years to life for murder. Roger Evans, 22, of New York, under sentence of 10 years for robbery was captured last night shortly after the escape.
