AT THE THEATERS

"Wings," Sound Picture, To Open on Sunday

The remarkable Sound synchronization, which started the thousands to see "Wings" at the Criterion theater, New York City, the Carlton theater in London and at other great theaters in the large cities of the world, where "Wings" played long runs to delighted audiences, will be heard when the Paramount epic of the "Aces" in the World war shows at the Arcade theater for four days, starting Sunday.

The master synchronization, which at the time of its introduction, was the first great Sound innovation, furnishes a splendid accompaniment for the wonders of the picture. Shoe Shop Puts In New Fastener

The Jester Shoe shop has recently installed a very interesting piece of machinery in their shop, a Champion Flexible Metallic Fastener, which does what its name implies, cares for the task of nailing soles of boots and shoes. This fastener is one of the latest pieces of machinery for this industry, and is the only one in La Grande. The number of the machine is 415, which indicates that it is the total number used at present. There is also one of the machines in Baker.

The machine uses a nail, which comes by the "roll" and in a number of sizes, ranging from 2 1/2 eighths to six-eighths with intermediate sizes by eighths. This means that soles may be stitched on, or rather nailed on from the finest lady's shoe to the heaviest, coarsest longer shoe. The time required for the attaching of a sole is about one half minute each. The machine makes an even stitch, and there is an even tension, the nails pointing the same way, which is an impossibility where the tacks are put in by hand. The result of the use of this machine is a greater flexibility, hence greater comfort, the operators at Jester's assert. The machine is a rather expensive piece of equipment, but is in keeping with the upward trend of labor evident everywhere.
