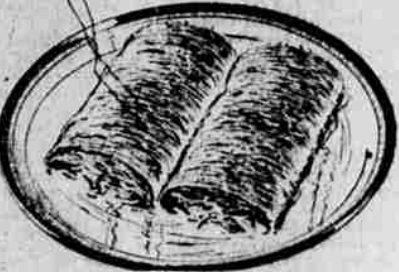
NEVILLE NOMINATED
