PEMICAN AND KLIM? SCOUTS KNOW OF THEM

"Boy, she's sure a food," ejaculates E. Russell Scott referring to pemican, which is a Boy Scout's favorite dish. "There's nothing like it," he says, describing an impartially, klim, camp stew, wilderness hash and the other delicious "foods for winter camping," which no one can make like a boy scout can, but which every one enjoys.

Now take, for instance, pemican. All one does to prepare this savory delicacy is to mix some ground up meat already cooked with raisins and cheese. Then fry, roast or make a soup of it. Ordinary pemican is a mixture of meat, raisins and cheese, which scouts put into a bag and sling over their shoulders. During a hike they dip their hands into the bag and eat the pemican by the handful as they want it. Mr. Scott says the cheese is used as a substitute for buffalo meat in case it can't be obtained.

Then, there's klim—it tastes just like milk, looks just like milk and babies can't tell it from milk! It is the essence of milk in powder form into which they dip their hands. When it isn't convenient to include a cow on the hiking trip klim does just as well.

Another delightful dish for winter campers, continues Mr. Scott, is campstew, which consists of canned tomatoes, corn, a half pound of bacon, a pinch of garlic and some chili powder mixed with lotted potatoes.

Wilderness hash is hamburger fried with tomato soup poured over it and onions mixed in it. Eaten with hot biscuits it is superb, Mr. Scott enthuses.

To start off a day of winter camping in snow or a cold vicinity a drink of snow, old hot water is as good as anything. Of course, hot chocolate is excellent because it is heavy in fats and sugar and is therefore heat giving.

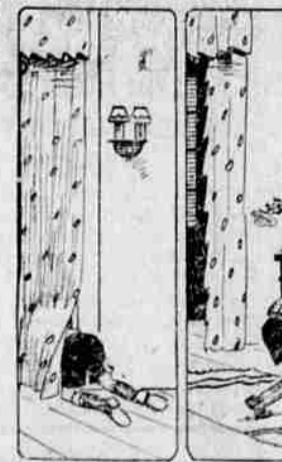
