A TRUE DUTCH COLONIAL

The Norman and English types of design undoubtedly seem to be the most popular, but our own American type, especially the Dutch Colonial, will always hold its own as an accepted and worthy design for small houses.

There is less waste space in this type of house than in any other one and a half-story structure that has as yet been designed. It would indeed be hard to imagine a design wherein so much beauty, available space, convenience of plan, and economic construction is contained within a space only eighteen by thirty feet.

Its white shingled walls resting on a concrete foundation, roofed with a blue-green shingled roof, blue-green shutters, and touch of color in the flower boxes beneath the bathroom windows, and climbing rose on the trellis would make this house an outstanding show place in any community.

Within we find a comfortable living room with a cheerful colonial fireplace and with rug-covered floor and bookshelves. There is abundance of furniture space, light, cross ventilation and closets throughout the house.

A novel coat closet opens from the main hall from which the stairs lead to the garage. This is undoubtedly the latest and one of the most satisfactory solutions of access to the garage when it is contained in the basement.

All the doors are of one panel design, eased with neat colonial casing. The porch and cellar floors are cement. Oak flooring is used in the principal rooms. The plastering is of smooth finish to allow for painting or papering. The plumbing fixtures throughout are a good grade, enamelware and the house is heated with a warm air furnace. This house would look equally well on an inside or corner lot forty feet wide.

It is estimated that this house can be built for from \$2,500 to \$4,000, exclusive of heating and plumbing.

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THE GARDEN

BUILDING UP FERTILITY

Fertilizers offer one of the big gardening problems. Lucky the gardener in this automobile age who has a farmer conveniently located to haul in stable manure for the garden, the best fertilizer of all. If stable manure is available, the fertilizer problem is solved. It should be applied at the rate of one to two tons to four square rods, according to some authorities. This doesn't convey much to the small gardener but reduced to terms of small dimensions it means about 10 to 32 pounds per square yard.

It is a rather elastic prescription as the weight of the manure will depend largely upon the amount of moisture it contains and whether it has been stored under cover or is rain soaked. The average well rotted manure delivered is pretty wet so the two ton direction is most practical.

If the soil is of good texture, the balanced commercial fertilizers offered by all seedhouses for vegetable gardens will serve every purpose. They are easy to apply, concentrated, and give the vegetables a quickly available supply of food. They are more efficient than barnyard manure for quick effect but do not give the soil the lasting benefit as they furnish no humus.

The home compost heap, now becoming a staple fixture with experienced gardeners, furnishes the humus necessary. It should be spread under in the same proportion as stable manure and with the commercial fertilizer added makes an ideal combination for fertility and Nitrate of soda is useful to give

lawn and gardens a flying start. It is particularly useful for stimulating the asparagus bed. It should be given lightly, a cupful to a square yard being a sufficiently liberal application.

Bone meal is a constituent of most of the commercial fertilizers and gives them a lasting quality as it is slow acting. It is excellent of itself as the benefits of this fertilizer will be manifested for at least a year in the garden. It is excellent for heavy soils.
