INDIAN FACES 10-YEAR TERM IN U. S. PRISON

PORTLAND, April 10 (AP)—Perry John, Klamath Indian, has been sentenced to ten years in McNeil Island federal prison for killing William Ward, white logger, in a cabin at Chiloquin, Feb. 7.
