## Lostine Couple Will Debate At Hermiston, Ore.

LOSTINE, Ore. (Special)—(School notes)—At Hermiston, Ore., on Friday, April 12, Melvin Crow and Esther Pfeiffer will uphold the negative side of the question—Resolved: That a graduated income tax should be made a feature of a state system of taxation. Mr. Crow and several students will accompany them.

Louis Crow's essay in the "Our Presidents' Contest," which was sponsored by the Current Events magazine, was selected as the best manuscript in Oregon. The contest was national in scope and there were 20,000 essays presented. The three grand prizes were given to students in eastern states. Three prize winners were then selected from each state. Louis has brought honor both to himself and to his school by winning the first prize for Oregon.
