Portland and Missions Rained Out--Sacramento Defeats Los Angeles

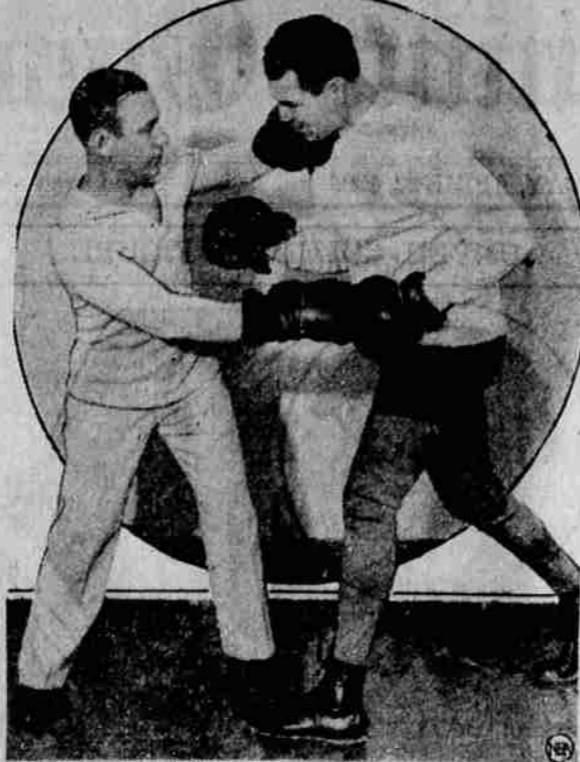

Campbell Fails To Smash Speed Mark

VERNEUK PAN, Cape of Good Hope, Apr. 22--(AP)--Captain Malcolm Campbell, famous British automobile racer, today expressed dissatisfaction over his failure to lower the world's speed record of 211 miles per hour, held by Major H. D. Segrave, in two runs over the measured mile course here yesterday.

In his first run over the course with a flying wind at his back, Captain Campbell attained a speed of 224.58 miles and when the wind that had delayed his attempt for several hours, sprang up again, he made only 212.61 on the return trip, for an average of 218.54 for both runs.

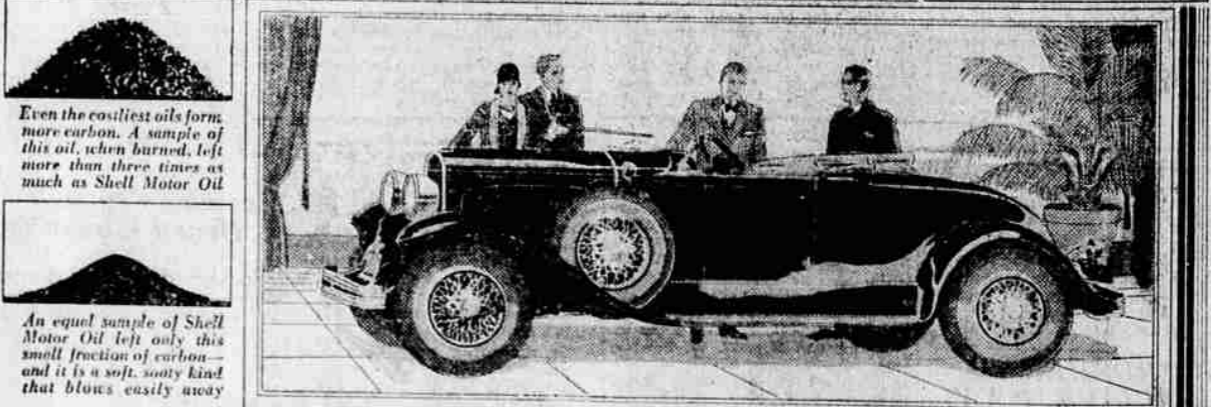
