William Rollins to Build New Residence on Twelfth Street

One permit in the amount of \$2,500 for a new home was issued during the last week in La Grande, along with six others, varying in size from \$50 to \$500. The total in permits for the week was \$4,400, bringing the total for the year so far to well above \$50,000.

The new home is to be erected in Commodore by William Rollins, on Twelfth between K and Washington.

The permits issued during the week follow:

Apr. 22—C. D. Goodnough, for Walter Reuter, to alter and repair a residence on First between Pennsylvanian and O, work to cost \$300.

Apr. 23—Clyde Sullivan, to alter and repair a home on Cedar between Jefferson and Cedar, work to cost \$350.

Apr. 24—C. D. Goodnough, for G. J. Stutzinger, to alter and repair a home on Monroe between Fir and Greenwood, no amount specified.

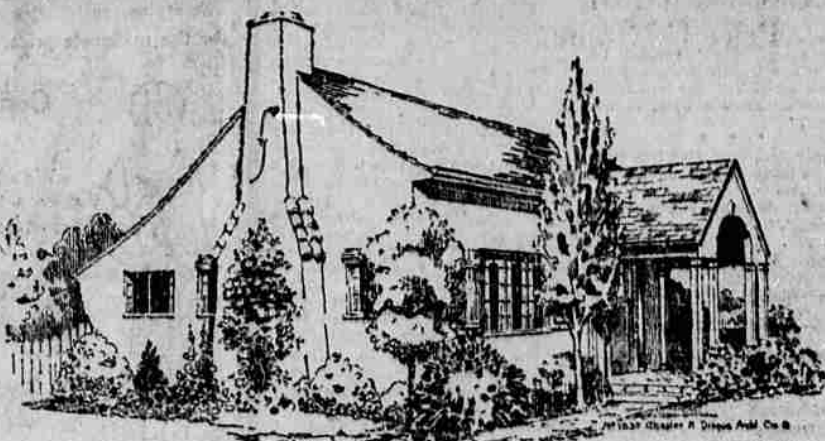
Apr. 24—F. S. Jester, to erect a garage and woodshed on Washington between Maple and Cherry, to cost \$250.

Apr. 25—William Rollins, to erect a one-story home on Twelfth between H and Washington, to cost \$2,500.

Apr. 26—E. Cade, to alter and repair a home on Jefferson between Oak and Cedar, work to cost \$50.

Apr. 27—Frank Robinson, to alter and repair a home on Hemlock between Washington and Adams, work to cost \$500.

A REAL HOME

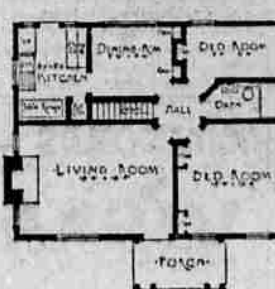

Who could ask for a more livable, efficient and compact home than is shown in the above sketch. We find herein two very distinctive features—the studio living-room and the octagon-shaped hallway, which permits one not only to enter every room in the house except the kitchen, but also admits one to the stairway leading to the garage in the basement. In case the grade permits. The living room and bedroom are good sized rooms and there is sufficient room in both the kitchen and dining room for every piece of furniture required, to say nothing of the distinctive china cases in the dining room. The small bedroom would be just the thing for a child or guest.

Study the plan carefully. It will bear close inspection and a little study will reveal its many possibilities and untold comforts and conveniences.

The plans are so drawn that either stucco or cinder-concrete blocks can be used for the walls and wood, asbestos or asphalt shingles for the roof. The exterior walls should be white with a dark red roof. Steel sash, hardwood



floors, single panel doors, rough plaster and a gum or chestnut trim are used throughout. The floor is in the bath. Warm air heat is used and entire basement is completed. A fifty foot lot would be ample as the house is only thirty-one feet six inches wide.
