Mission Reds and Hollywood Stars Break Even - Sacs Win Two Games.

Hollywood and the Mission Reds shared a couple of hot, interesting contests, the Stars winning the morning game 5 to 2, and the afternoon session going to the Reds 4 to 2. The morning victory gave the Stars the series, the first home series the Hollywood Stars had since 1927.

The San Francisco Seals won their series with Los Angeles four games to three by taking the short games of the double bill, ten to nine. The Angels took the first game 10 to 5. The nightcap was ended in the fifth inning to allow the Seals to catch a train northward.
