SALEM, Ore., June 3 (AP)-A total sum of \$56,116.61 in county fair funds has been apportioned among the counties of the state by the secretary of state, it was announced Saturday.

This is a joy of one-twentieth mill on a total taxable property valuation in the state of \$1,122,342,180.42 with \$394,617 additional due to the legal provision that Multnomah county shall not receive over \$16,500 from the levy. The Multnomah county even of \$109,419 for each county is required by law to be used for road purposes.

Among the apportionments are the following: Baker county, \$1247.89; Coos, \$1453.71; Douglas, \$1670.14; Jack-

son, \$1624.55; Josephine, \$494.23; Klamath, \$827.76; Lane, \$2731.67; Marion, \$2915.40; Multnomah, \$16,269.49; Umatilla, \$2435.24; Union, \$1199.27; Willowa, \$626.91.

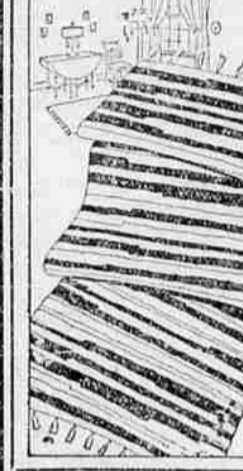
