Prune Buyers Are Active In Oregon ROSHSIDE, Ore., June 27 (AP)—Early activities of buyers endeavoring to contract prunes to cover orders, particularly for export, has resulted in the earliest opening of the prune market in many years. Locally little buying is done until after the California price is quoted, about the middle of July, and for several past years the buyers have not been in the field to any extent until the packing season was in progress. This year, however, buyers are already contracting the country and are trying to contract for delivery, but so far have met with little success.

Prices, which at first fluctuated widely, have now been pretty well stabilized. Buyers are offering 5 cents for 2-25 per cent.

500,000 Bushels Of Wheat Contracted BENDLETON, Ore., June 27 (AP)—C.A.P. between 500,000 and 600,000 bushels of new crop wheat has been contracted here according to well-informed sources in the wheat industry. Prices are said to range from one dollar to \$1.05 or a trifle higher.

Wheat Heavy, Two Cents Lower Today CHICAGO, June 27 (AP)—Wheat rains reported both in Canada and in domestic spring wheat territory, wheat prices here underwent an early setback today. Liverpool wheat quotations that were higher than those and were associated with talk of possible cancellation of shipments from Argentina attracted but little notice. Opening at the decline, to the advance, Chicago wheat later underwent a material decline all around. Corn, oats and provisions were easy, with corn starting unchanged to 1/2c higher and subsequently showing a general rise. Wheat closes heavy, 1c to 1/2c net lower, corn & 2c down, oats 1/2c to 3/4c off and provisions falling 2c to a 2 1/2c decline.

Hundreds Of Cars Of Melons Daily CHICAGO, June 27 (AP)—Watermelons are being marketed here at the rate of a carload every minute and a half, day and night. A report from the government bureau of agricultural economics said the supply so far this season averaged two and a half times as large as a year ago. Taking the country as a whole, more than 1000 cars of melons daily have been shipped during the last week, the exact total being 7,200 cars. Georgia and Texas furnished most of the melons.
