

### Union Sawmill Again Operating; Cars Bring Logs

UNION, Special.—The Oregon trail sawmill is again running steadily since the rainy season is over and trucks can get into the mountains of logs. Most of the timber being sawed now is from the J. E. Hall ranch about ten miles up Catherine creek. Tex Knight is in charge of a line of logging trucks which is bringing in the logs from this section of timber.

Headquarters company of the national guard arrived here Thursday morning, with the expectation of a few of the boys who obtained permission to remain in Portland for a few days. The guardmen report a good time at Camp Clatsop this year.

Ranchers in this end of the valley are in the midst of the first cutting of alfalfa for the season and are finding the yield heavy. Grain fields are also promising a good average from the present indications.

Preparations are getting under way to handle the cherry crop of this vicinity and from the Cove district. Packing houses are being renovated and box material is being delivered for the making of boxes. Packers are offering a little over nine cents for Royal Ann and the other varieties will probably bring a slightly higher price. In general the trees are well filled and growers are anticipating a good yield.

### WATER POWER IN MCKINZIE BASIN GIVEN

PORTLAND, Ore., July 5 (AP)—The Oregonian, in a special dispatch from its Washington, D. C. correspondent, stated today that water power resources of the McKinzie river basin in Oregon amount to 442,000 horse power for 50 per cent of the time and 289,000 horse power for 90 per cent of the time.

"If all the sites were developed," the article states, "the total usable power would equal twice the present requirements of Oregon, according to the findings published by the geological survey."

"The only power now developed in the basin is the 4200 horse power available at the Eugene, Ore., municipal plant. A second plant near Leaburg is being built by the city of Eugene and will have an initial capacity of 10,000 horse power and an ultimate capacity of 20,000 horse power."
