Choose Davis Cup Team For Opener In France Friday

NEW YORK, July 22 (AP)—Selection of the United States Davis cup team to play France in the challenge round starting this Friday in Paris, with George Lott of Chicago substituted for Francis T. Hunter of New York, was announced today by the United States lawn tennis association.

The other three members are Bill Tilden, Wilmer Allison of Austin, Texas, and John Van Ryan of Orange, N. J.

Tilden and Lott will play in the singles while the crack combination of Allison and Van Ryan, which has been cutting a sensational figure abroad, will play the doubles.

Lott's replacement of Hunter is the only change from the lineup which defeated Germany, 5 to 0, in the inter-zone competition concluded yesterday at Berlin.

No official explanation of the shift was contained in the announcement of team selection by Joseph W. Wear, of Philadelphia, chairman of the Davis cup committee.
