MENUS

Although beets are one of those vegetables which may be stored in a dry, cool place and kept as long as potatoes, there are several reasons why it's worth while canning them.

Beets which are to be stored must not be harvested until they are full grown and mature, while those which are to be canned should be gathered while they are small and tender, early in the season. Experiments have been made which indicate that there is less loss of vitamins from canning than from storage and that fresh young vegetables are likely to contain more vitamins to begin with than the old ones. The long cooking period necessary to make "winter" beets tender is more or less harmful to the vitamin content, and also develops a strong flavor unpalatable to many persons.

A Tasty Garnish

A few jars of pickled beets are convenient to have on hand. They make an excellent garnish for salads cut in fancy shapes and are an appetizing accompaniment with fish or fowl. The process is so simple as recipe is necessary. Cooked and sliced beets are packed in sterilized jars and boiling vinegar is poured over to fill jar perfectly full. The jar is sealed at once. A good rule for the vinegar is 1 cup granulated sugar and 1 teaspoon salt to each quart of vinegar.

Of can beets, first wash them thoroughly and carefully, taking care not to scratch and break the skin. Cut off leaves leaving two inches of stem. Do not cut any of the root. Cook in boiling water until the skins slip easily. It should take about 20 minutes.
