

### TROEH FAVORITE FOR GUN TITLE

Portland Shooter and Gus Payne, of Oklahoma, Have Best Chance.

VANDALIA, Ohio, Aug. 22 (AP)—Frank Troeh, of Portland, Ore., and Gus Payne, of Oklahoma City, appeared today as the leading candidates for the grand American handgun trap shooting championship, to be held at the shooting grounds here tomorrow at the culmination of the North American tournament in session here since Monday.

Troeh yesterday won the championship of all state champions in a final match with Payne, after the two had broken 199 out of 200 targets. Troeh broke the next 25 extra shots in the shoot-off, but Payne missed one.

A preliminary match for entrance to the grand American Handicap was scheduled today at 10 targets from the 15 to 25 yard line.

Guy V. Deering of Columbus, Wis., was elected president of the American Handicapping association last night. Vice presidents elected were John W. Schelmann, Lancaster, Pa., and Isaac Andrews, Sparta, N. C.; Sam Sherman, Salt Lake City, Utah, was chosen vice president to succeed O. N. Ford, of Del Monte, California.

### Round-Trip Flight Finish Tomorrow

ROOSEVELT FIELD, Aug. 22 (AP)—Captain Roseos Turner and his three passengers prepared today for a return trip to the Pacific coast in their flight to demonstrate the feasibility of one-day transcontinental air passenger service.

They arrived here last night from Glendale, Cal., having made the cross country flight in 19 hours and 53 minutes, with three refueling stops. The return flight will be made tomorrow.

### Two Killed In West Frankfort Liquor Battle

WEST FRANKFORT, Ill., Aug. 22 (AP)—Earl Krieger and Albert McDonald were shot to death by Police Chief Leroy Fisk last night after the chief and Patrolman George Snipper stopped their motor car in the downtown district to search it for liquor.

Krieger is said to have fired first at the officers. Fisk fired four shots from a sawed-off shotgun, hitting both in the head and killing them instantly.

An inquest is scheduled here today. Fisk was placed under technical arrest and held in jail at Benton.

Krieger and McDonald were about 35 years old.

### Theater Owner To Enter Plea This Afternoon

LOS ANGELES, Aug. 22 (AP)—Alexander Pantagos, 54 multi-millionaire theater operator, was to appear in superior court at 2 p. m. today and plead to charges of attacking Enrico Pringis, 17-year-old girl dancer at his private offices August 9.

Defense attorneys have indicated that the theater magnate will enter a plea of not guilty to the two assault charges filed against him. They said they would ask a reasonable time to prepare their case.

Buron Pitts, district attorney, announced that the state will ask the trial be set for Sept. 17. Two other cases in superior court have priority. Coincident is the fact that one of those is the second degree murder charge filed against Mrs. Pantagos.

The theater operator's wife must go to trial Sept. 2 for the death of Joe Tokumoto who was killed when the machine which he was driving, collided with the automobile driven by Mrs. Pantagos. Witnesses at her preliminary hearing said she was driving while intoxicated.

Pantagos was found over to superior court last Friday following a preliminary hearing. Judge Leonard Wilson held that the evidence submitted left "sufficient cause for belief that the defendant is guilty." The theater owner is at liberty on \$25,000 bond.

### Simmons To Visit Home For Few Days

ST. LOUIS, Aug. 22 (AP)—Al Simmons, athletic outfielder, has been granted permission by Connie Mack to visit his home in Milwaukee for a few days.

"A few days rest will be a good thing for him," the manager explained, "and a few days rest will be a good thing for him."

Walter French, in left field for Simmons, played football at West point.

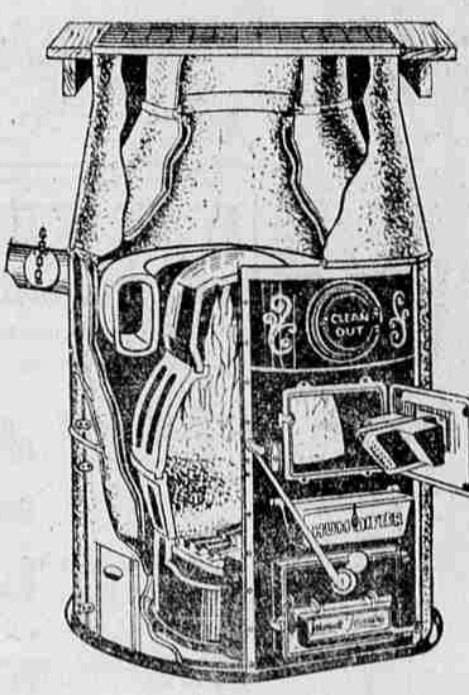
### SHADE BEATS DIXON IN TEN ROUND SCRAP

Shade weighed 158 1/2 pounds, Dixon 157 3/4. Nine thousand people paid approximately \$15,000 to see the fight.
