Jones and Homans tie for Medal Honors — Oregonians Stroke behind.

PEBBLE BEACH, Cal., Sept. 4. (AP)—The boys have come out of the qualifying trenches, a trifle battered, and it's a man-to-man battle from now on for the amateur golf championship of the United States.

Led from the wind-blown hazards of Pebble Beach by Bobby Jones and Gene Homans, who tied for medal honors with total of 145, one over par, in the 36-hole qualifying tournament. The 23 survivors were paired for the elimination match play today. Two 18-hole rounds faced the reduced field of 11 contestants which by nightfall will be abruptly reduced to a select eight for the quarter-finals tomorrow over the 36-hole route.

No Shift in Odds
Although out-played first by a college boy from the University of California at Los Angeles, Gibson Boning, on the opening day of the qualifying competition, and then held to even terms after 36 holes by another collegian, Eugene V. Homans of Princeton, Bobby Jones began the main struggle for the defense of his crown without any shift in the odds in his favor.

The champion star Johnny Goodman, who qualified with 157, for his first round opponent, with the prospect that he would be called on in the afternoon to battle the long-driving California entry, Phillip Finley, hero yesterday of an dramatic come-back as the qualifying round has ever witnessed.

Homans, the studious looking son of a former famous Princeton football player, was bracketed with Ray Coleman of Colby, 150, California; while Finley, the hero of opening day, drew Clarence Hubby of Dallas, Texas. The first match today brought together two outstanding stars in Cyril Tolley, the British champion, and Eddie Held of New York, holder of the Canadian title who was forced to play-off for the right to continue in the tournament. Another fine attraction involved George Von Elm of Detroit, champion in 1928, and Chandler Egan of Medford, Oregon, titleholder in 1924-25.

Pebble Beach, or a breezy day, gave the field a real taste of its terrors as the qualifying round was concluded. After the battle was over, the scoreboard not only showed a succession of narrow escapes for a good share of the favorites, but a equally list that included conspicuous names as Chick Evans, two-time former champion, Ross Sommerville and Don Varrick, former Canadian titleholder, and these ex-holders of the western amateur title. Boning, a senior at the University of California at Berkeley, and Egan, a senior at the University of Oregon, were the only two to finish in the top 10.
