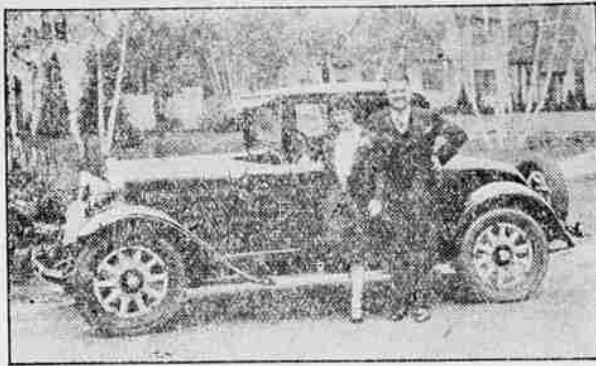


BUY TWO AUTOS TO SOLVE NEEDS

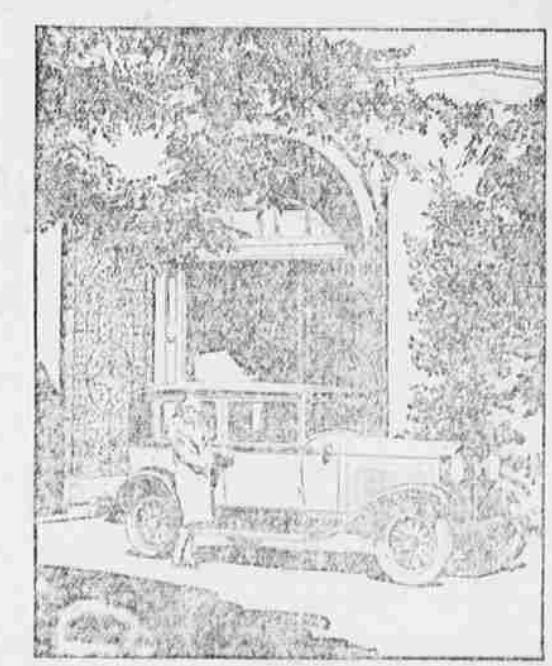
