Wheat Unsettled And Some Higher

CHICAGO, Sept. 12 (AP)—Indications that Argentina will raise but little more than half as much wheat as last year gave a break early upturn to wheat prices today. Reports implied that Argentina wheat was going back fast and that chances of recuperation were reduced. Opening at 1/2 to 3/4 advance, wheat values here scored further gains. Corn, oats and provisions were also firmer, with each starting at 1/4 to 1 cent rise, and holding near to the initial figures.

Prosecution Rests In Pantages Case

LOS ANGELES, Sept. 12 (AP)—The state rested its case against Mrs. Lois Pantages, on trial for second degree murder, at 11 a. m. today, the eighth day of the trial. Presenting Attorney James P. Costello made the announcement following a five minute court recess, during which he abandoned a previous plan to call to the witness stand Mrs. Teruko Rokumoto, widow of Juro Rokumoto. The murder charge against Mrs. Pantages was the result of the death of the latter following the collision of her automobile with the Rokumoto car.

Holy Land Danger Over, British Say

JERUSALEM, Sept. 12 (AP)—British troops have been withdrawn from Palestine areas as fast as quiet has been restored and danger of further Arab-Semite clashes has passed, an official announcement said today. A system of mobile patrols will be maintained in the districts where the detachments have been withdrawn. The number of British troops now in Palestine are considered fully adequate to deal with any situation which may arise. Danger of Bedouin invasion is considered past.
