Smith Tells of Loop

H. W. Smith, field secretary of the Wallowa National Park association, described the movement of tourists from east to west declaring that 75 per cent of them now take the southern route through the Grand Canyon, the hot desert land of the Southwest, and then into California, visiting Yosemite, General Grant, Sequoia and Mt. Lassen national parks before the few who continue on to reach the Oregon country and the Crater Lake park. Of the 75 per cent that takes the southern route, only a small number ever reach Eastern Oregon, he said, most of them either turning back at The Dalles or else going into Washington to visit Rainier national park.

The Wallowa national park would complete a great loop trip that would permit tourists from the east and midwest to come west either on the southern route or the Old Oregon Trail route, returning the other way. The northern route would present marvelous and ever-changing scenery, with no long, disagreeable stretches of desert land to cross, he said. The Wallowa national park would link up with a chain including the Yellowstone, the Craters of the Moon, and Topsy Mountain national parks, the Shoshone Falls (more beautiful and larger than Niagara Falls), the Arrow Rock dam and later the Glacier national park through Lewiston, or the Canadian points through Lewiston or Walla Walla.

Also Smaller Loops

This park would also form smaller loops, having an outlet through Baker into Central Oregon and Crater Lake, and many other similar trips. Mr. Smith predicted that if such a project materialized, hundreds of thousands of tourists would flock into Eastern Oregon, Western Idaho and Southwestern Washington each year, leaving a rich crop of dollars in their path in every community in the area. California reaped a crop of one and a quarter billion dollars in one year from four parks, he pointed out. Other figures he presented showed 231,000 Yellowstone visitors in one year. A total of 220,000 visited Rainier national park, 114,000 visited Crater Lake and 461,000 visited the Yosemite. "We can count on an average of 200,000 in the first five years if other figures are a criterion," he said, adding, however, that such a number could not be expected the first year or two.

Discussing Wallowa county, Mr. Smith said that he and his associates have secured accurate data to offset any antagonism there, and that he is now informed that many are favorable to the national park idea. Whether this percentage is in the minority or majority, he has not yet learned, but in the near future the campaign will be taken into the Wallowa county.

Speaking of the park area, he said that less than 3000 sheep were originally affected, and that since the boundaries have been amended, less than 5,000 are affected. There are only seven grazing permits in the district, and all of these extend outside the park territory, he said. In addition, it is possible that grazing may be permitted in the national park, by said. Most of the rich grazing areas have been excluded from the proposed park boundaries.

Mr. Smith pointed out that the park would benefit 1,250,000 people in the Inland Empire compared with the possible taking of part of the grazing areas now enjoyed by seven sheep men, with Wallowa county to realize thousands of dollars from tourists to offset a possible loss of \$455 annually paid to Wallowa county by the government as part of revenue secured from sheep-grazing permits.

Great Advertising Value

G. L. Larison, in a brief talk, outlined the advertising advantages that would accrue to Eastern Oregon through a national park, pointing out that advertising not to be bought for less than half a million dollars would be given the park annually, free of charge, by the government, railroads, tourist bureaus, and word of mouth. He compared the park with the sun—once started, it automatically continues. He said that such advertisement would improve the entire district, bringing permanent settlers here as well as thousands of tourists. "If we can get the appreciation of the rest of the country, our problems will be easy," he said.

In referring to accomplishments of the national park association here, he said that as much has been done in eight months as it ordinarily takes four years to achieve, mentioning the forthcoming survey of the Upper Lake Basin, country by Horace Albright, director of national parks. However, he added, the work will require much more help, including more finances, and cities of the Inland Empire—enthusiastic supporters of the plan—are looking to La Grande, the gateway city, to take the lead in the organization movement. He said that the point had been reached where this work must begin.

Ang. J. Stanga likened the Upper Lake Basin to a gold mine merely awaiting development and exploitation. "We ought to get out of the world what we put into it, and we've got to work," he emphasized. "If La Grande wants a national park there, we've got to fight for it."

Richardson Speaks

Harley Richardson, who is familiar with most of the beauty spots of America, paid a high tribute to the scenery in the Upper Lake basin, declaring that it is unlike anything else in the United States in a scenic way. "We have within our reach one of the resources that would mean most to this part of the country," he asserted. "From a commercial standpoint it would bring many dollars into the territory, and from a sentimental standpoint, it would be the perpetuation of a wonderful monument for all time."
