Former School Teacher Is New Head of Legion

LOUISVILLE, Ky., Oct. 4 (AP)—A school teacher who enlisted during the World war as a private and was discharged as a major is the story of O. L. Bodenhamer, of El Dorado, Ark., who was elected national commander of the American Legion here Thursday. He is 39 years old and is not married.

As a member of the legion's national executive committee, the new commander has long been active in legion work, especially its rehabilitation, legislative and child welfare schemes. He is a past commander of the Arkansas department and was chairman of the national legislative committee in 1924-1925.

A native of Goldthwaite, Texas, Commander Bodenhamer was educated at Howard Payne college and Baylor university. After receiving his degree he became a professor of English and dean of San Marcos college, acting as coach of athletics.

He entered service for the World war in April 1917 as a recruit and was discharged from the 19th infantry, regular army, in July, 1919, as a major.

After the war he entered the real estate business in El Dorado. He also is president of the El Dorado chamber of commerce.
