As a result, the Kuomintang forces are withdrawing to the west and the Nationalists are approaching Loyang.

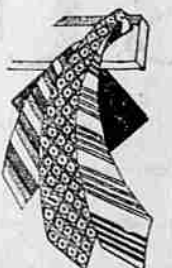

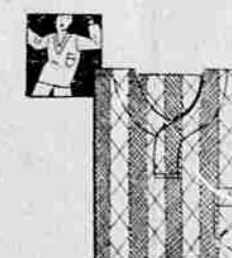
