RENO, Nov. 8 (AP)—Eight large cabin planes were ready for a takeoff at nine o'clock this morning to carry the University of Nevada football squad and its corps of trainers and coaches to Los Angeles where the "sweet pack" will meet the University of Southern California Trojans Saturday.

The flight, a distance of more than 400 miles, is expected to take three and a half hours, the regular flying time of the Nevada Air Lines company, which operates a daily service between the two cities.
