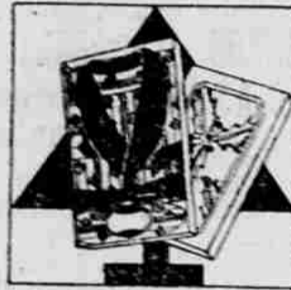

PHIL SCOTT WINS BATTLE ON FOUL

Crowd Peeved at Unsatisfactory Finish to Bout in Gotham.

New York, Dec. 9 (AP)—Phil Scott, the Glasgow British heavyweight champion, today won the possession of a ring decision that proved nothing more or less than a technicality.

Scott, Phil, with an agonized groan that seemed prompted more than by second thought, fell to the ground in the second round on his head with the back-thumping Norwegian, Ole Von Furek, last night. After considerable hesitation and a good deal of reluctance upon the part of the referee, Scott was awarded the victory on a foul to the advantage of Scott, a technicality that disappeared from the crowd of some 15,000 fans.

At least six inches below the belt, by a sweeping left that Von Furek started from somewhere near the floor. To the surprise of ring-side observers, as well as to Dempsey, it appeared that Scott was not really hurt. In fact, Dempsey seemed to think the fight should go on and made some futile gesture to bring this about.

Scott, however, was writhing in apparent agony upon the floor. The crowd seemed to feel that it had been cheated of the exciting entertainment, regardless of the merit of the decision.

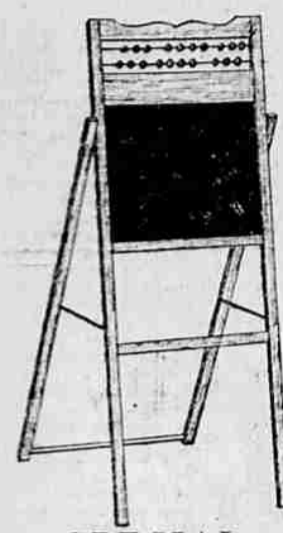
