Champion Johnny Layton, Geo. Reitselt and Andy Keckhefer will battle down to the finish line. Each has dropped one game but Keckhefer has yet to meet the brilliant Allan Hall of St. Louis and Tiff Denon of Kansas City.

Layton and Reitselt are booked to match eyes in their closing encounter Friday night.

Copulos tossed a bomb-shell into Reitselt's well laid plans, when he equaled the world's high run tournament record of 17 billiards in the opening inning of their match last night. Reitselt staged a courageous uphill battle but lost 50 to 45 in 45 innings.

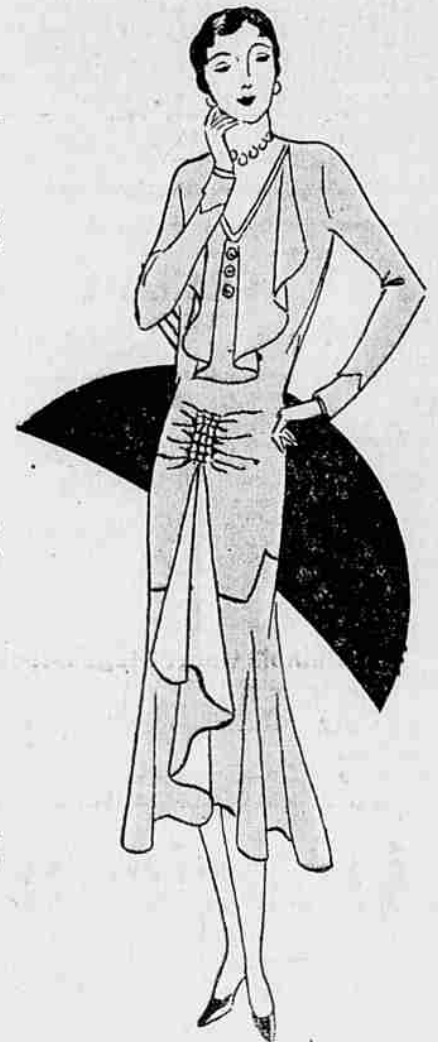
