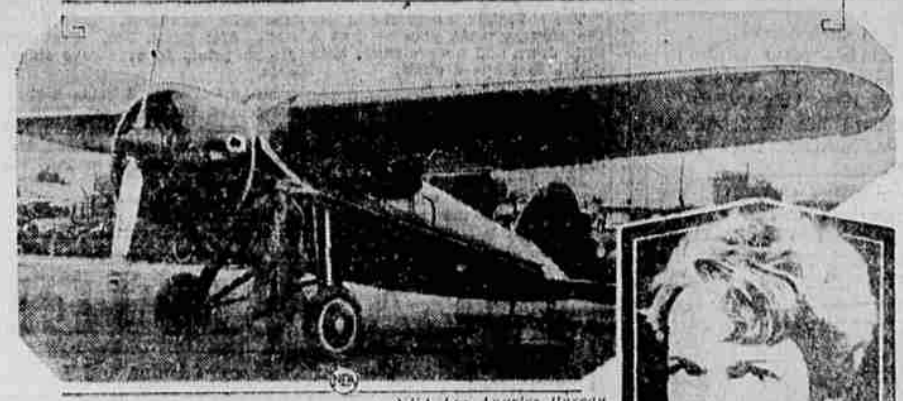

WOMAN SENATOR DIES

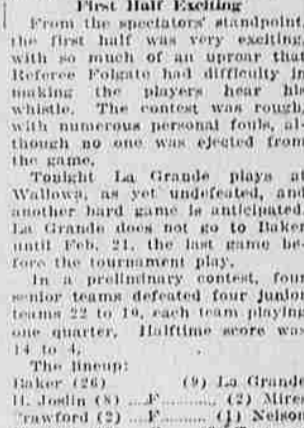
