Little children who have not tasted over-sweet foods will not crave them and will be satisfied with the desserts provided for them.

The training of a child's appetite is of utmost importance. Proper eating habits have direct bearing on his growth and may have much influence on his susceptibility to disease and over-fatigue all through his life.

Food that is too highly flavored soon makes children dissatisfied with simple, wholesome foods that promote growth and provide nourishment. Very sweet desserts such as pie and cake have the tendency to take away the desire for vegetables and cereals and increase the appetite for more sweets.

Every child should have some suitable, sweet food to eat at the proper time. If sweets are eaten on an empty stomach, there is danger of digestive upsets. At the end of a meal a reasonable amount of something sweet seldom has a disturbing effect and may be served to children with safety.

should be those which take the least amount of sugar to make them palatable. Prunes are mildly acid but need only a minimum of sweetening. It is more desirable to use sugar to bring out the full flavor of other foods, as in stewed fruits, than to use it in a more concentrated form, as in pastries.

Jelly spread thinly on bread is satisfying and not harmful for small children, but preserves usually are eaten in larger quantities and are too rich with sugar for little children.

Baked apples, slightly sweetened custards, gelatinos, hard cookies, not too rich or sweet with junket and stewed fruit, offer children a variety of desserts that will not develop appetites for sweets in preference to the staple nourishing foods.

Cook gelatin pudding will please a child two or three years old.

**Cocoa Gelatine Pudding**  
One teaspoon gelatin, 4 teaspoons cold water, 1-2 cup milk, 4 teaspoon cocoa, 2 teaspoons granulated sugar, few grains salt, 1 drop vanilla.

Soften gelatin in cold water for five minutes. Mix sugar and cocoa with 1 tablespoon boiling water and cook and stir over the fire for one minute. Add milk and salt and bring to the boiling point but do not let boil. Pour over gelatin and stir until gelatin is dissolved. Pour into a mold, add vanilla and let stand until firm and cold. Unmold and serve with milk or cream.
