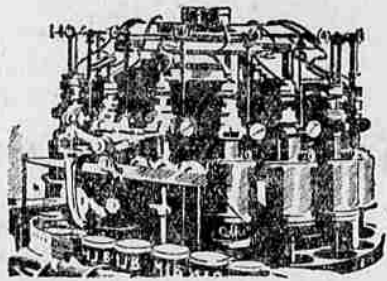

SHIP FORCED BACK TO PORT DUE TO CRASH

HOQUIAM, Wash., Feb. 4 (AP)—Quitting its voyage to San Francisco after striking a rock along the coast north of here, the steam schooner John C. Kirkpatrick, carrying 25 men, was making its way peacefully back to Puget Sound last night.
