TWO BIG FIGHTS ON FRIDAY BILL

Walker and Lomski Meet in Detroit—Rosenbloom and Hudkins in Gotham

DETROIT, Feb. 11 (AP)—The question of whether the top bulldog of the Aberdeen division will have the best right to ask for a chance at Jimmy Flattery, who the New York boxing commission says is the light heavyweight champion, will be decided at Olympia stadium tonight.

Mickey Walker and Leo Lomski, who fight again a few months after mixing it to an ending not universally satisfactory, both have expressed a desire to meet Flattery in a championship match. Lomski, however, has asserted that, whether he defeats Walker or not, he feels certain Flattery will not meet him.

The ex-heavyweight, present middleweight champion who now has his eye on the light heavyweight title, was given the referee's decision when he met Lomski at Philadelphia last summer, but not all of the experts at the ring-side agreed that Walker had won. Hope for a more definite outcome tonight was generally expressed.

Walker will weigh in at 165 pounds or thereabouts, while Lomski will be about 7 or 8 pounds heavier. Elmer McClelland, Detroit, will be the third man in the ring.

ROSENBLUM needs to win to secure himself of a battle with Jimmy Flattery, of Hartford, newly crowned light heavyweight champion as far as New York state is concerned. Flattery was designated as the champion by virtue of his victory over Leo Sobona on Monday night, but the New York state commission ruled he must meet Rosenbloom within 60 days with the championship at stake.

Maxey's unorthodox style has enabled him to slip his way to decisive victories over most of the leading light heavyweights in the business. The betting fraternity are ready to lay odds of 8 to 5 that he outpoints Hudkins who will be marking his New York debut as a 145-pounder.

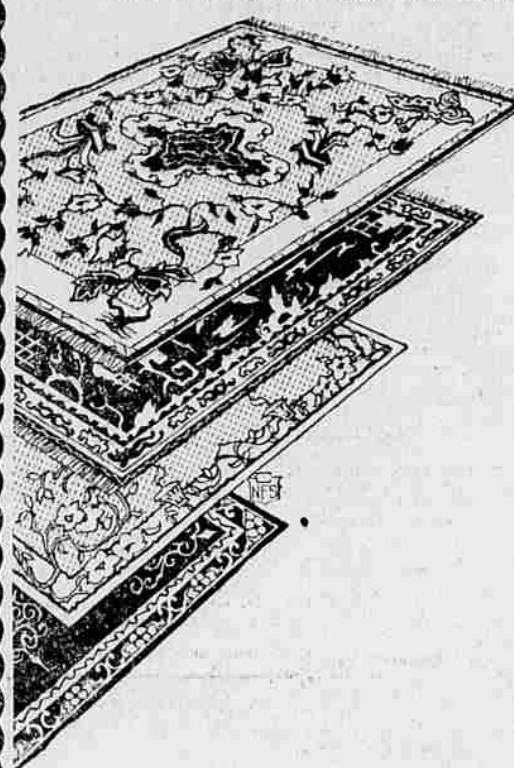
