Young Firpo Beats Canadian Fighter
 PORTLAND, Ore., Feb. 19 (AP)—Guido Bardello, better known as Young Firpo, light heavyweight of Turke, Idaho, took a 12-round decision from Del Fontaine, Winnipeg, here last night. Firpo might have had the fight in the second round on a foul, but chose to give the big crowd a run for their money and came back to chase Fontaine around the ring for eight more rounds. After putting Firpo down in the second round, Fontaine clipped him on the chin while the Bucks miner was on his hands preparing to get up. He refused the foul and came back to even matters in the next round by flooring Fontaine with a left to the jaw. In the semi-final Neil Kilbane, 155-pound College of Puget Sound student took a decision over Lou Sauer, Portland, after some hard exchanges. Kilbane dropped Sauer for a 10-11-11 of time in the third round.

Jack Berg Knocks Out Mr. Callahan
 LONDON, Feb. 19 (AP)—Jack (Kid) Berg apparently is just as effective a batter in his native England as he has been in the United States.
 The Whitechapel Hebrew stopped Mushy Callahan of Chicago, in the tenth round of a 15-round bout here last night. Callahan's seconds tossing in the towel to save the American from further punishment. The battle was billed as a "Junior welterweight" title contest but Callahan no longer is recognized as the 140-pound champion either by the New York state athletic commission or the National Boxing association.
