TURKS GLOOMY WITH TOURIST TRADE SLUMP

By Priscilla King (Associated Press Correspondent) ISTANBUL (AP)—On the heels of this summer's failure of agricultural crops which have helped to create a serious economic crisis, Turkey is now sadly witnessing the failure of another crop—the winter's harvest of American tourists.

Not even the prospect of 60,000 German visitors disperses the gloom. Tourist agencies estimate that there will be at least a twenty-five per cent decrease in the number of Americans visiting Turkey this winter as compared with the 25,000 who came last season.

German tourists are coming in crowds. At least 40,000 Germans, double the number visiting the city of Constantinople last year, are expected here this winter. But tourist agencies and business men do not consider this additional influx of Germans a compensation for the decrease in Americans.

ANGORA (AP)—Turkey's first unemployment figures which have just been published show that 41 per cent of her population of 14,000,000 are jobless.
