Seven National A. A. U. Champions On Trojan's Stellar Track Squad

LOS ANGELES (AP)—With an array of outstanding tracksters including seven national A. A. U. champions available, Dean Cromwell, Southern California coach, is molding a team which has more than casual designs on Pacific coast and national titles.



Such a collection of material has made the loss, by graduation, of Charley Borah, sprinter supreme; Jesse Hill, I. C. A. A. A. broad-jump champion, and others, seem insignificant by comparison. Heading the list of A. A. U. title holders stands Jess Mortenson, captain of the 1929 cinder crushers, whose 294 feet 9.75 inches heave in the javelin at Denver last summer, won for him the senior championship with a new record.

Two of the seven are hurdlers making their first appearance in the Trojan ranks. Ed Walsh holds the junior A. A. U. high hurdle title which he won in 14.5 seconds. Bill Carl holds the low barrier junior championship, negotiating the 220-yard race in 24.8 seconds.

To replace Hill in the broad jump the Trojans have Dick Barber, also a newcomer, who leaped into first place in the A. A. U. event with a 24 foot 2 1/2 inch mark.

The remaining trio of national champions are sprinters who were members of the record breaking half mile relay team at Denver. Frank Wykoff, member of the 1928 Olympic team, is the leader of these

speed burners, all of whom have marks of 9 1/2 seconds or better, to their credit. Maurice Gayer is best at the furlong distance, but like Milton Mauser, the other dash expert, Wykoff is strongest in the century race.

LENDLETON WINS IN FIRST ROUND

Buckaroos Defeat Dallas at Salem 30-22, Baker to Play This Afternoon.

SALEM, Ore., Mar. 20 (AP)—When the timer's gong ended the first day's play in the 10th annual Oregon state interscholastic basketball tournament being held under the auspices of Willamette university, Commerce of Portland and Eugene stood out as strong contenders for the championship. Eight teams went into the struggle on the maple floor during Wednesday, four of them being eliminated. Four more quints are scheduled to make their initial bows during Thursday to the large crowds which are attending the classic.

Portland, but on the hottest battle of the opening day, the former displayed the best teamwork and the best marksmanship to defeat the Railroaders, 30 to 20. Apparently extremely nervous at the outset of the contest, both teams displayed considerable wildness, with Labeon failing to score a field goal during the first period which found Commerce leading 8 to 2. The half ended, Commerce 17, Labeon 8.

Labeon put up a stiff fight during the third period to annex 7 points, while Commerce was content to check in with 6. The Commerce machine had the best of the rough going in the final minutes of play and advanced its lead.

The second game of the evening found North Bend and Tillamook fighting a nip and tuck battle, with neither side being able to do much in the sewing line. It was one of the closest games ever played here, insofar as scoring was concerned, the Cheesemakers winning out in the final minutes by the score of 13 to 11.

Eugene played a cool game in the afternoon to pile up a commanding lead over the Redmond quint, the final score being 51 to 25.

Pendleton Wins
Dallas went into the consolation series during the afternoon when it failed to stop the Buckaroo from Pendleton, who won 30 to 22. The Polk county lads out-named the Eastern Oregonians in the second half but could not overcome the lead Pendleton had amassed during the first quarters.

The second day of battle finds Ashland and Astoria staging a championship game at 10:30 a. m., while Salem and Baker, two other quints which have not displayed their wares as yet, will clash at 4:30 this afternoon.

The consolation series will open Thursday forenoon with Redmond and Dallas scheduled to meet at 9:30. Labeon, eliminated Wednesday night is expected to have an easy time with North Bend, in the second game of the side show.

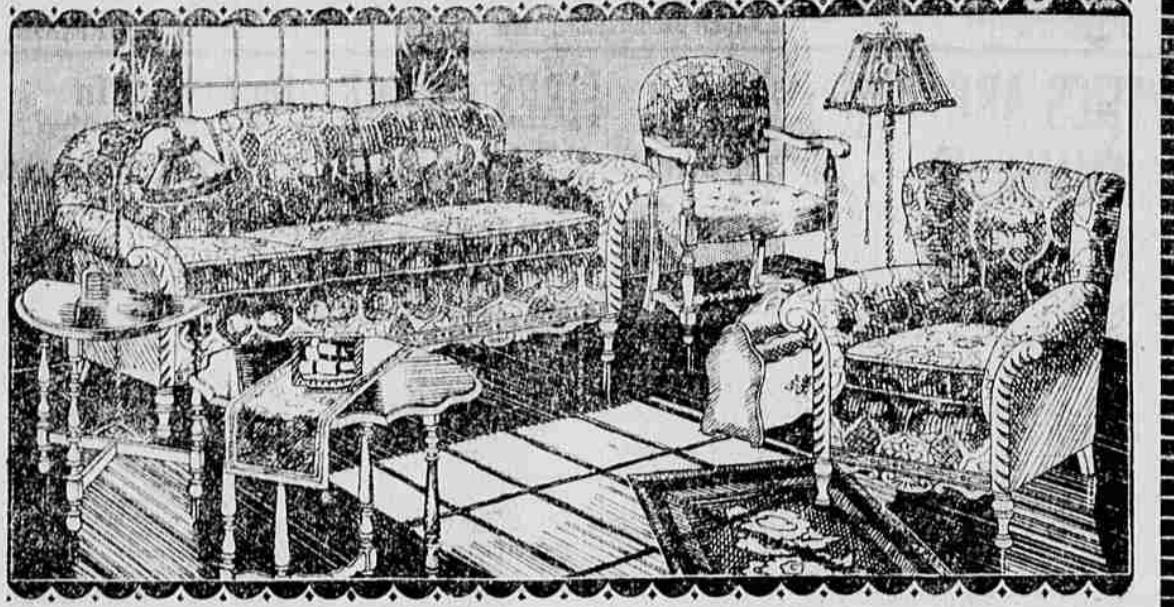

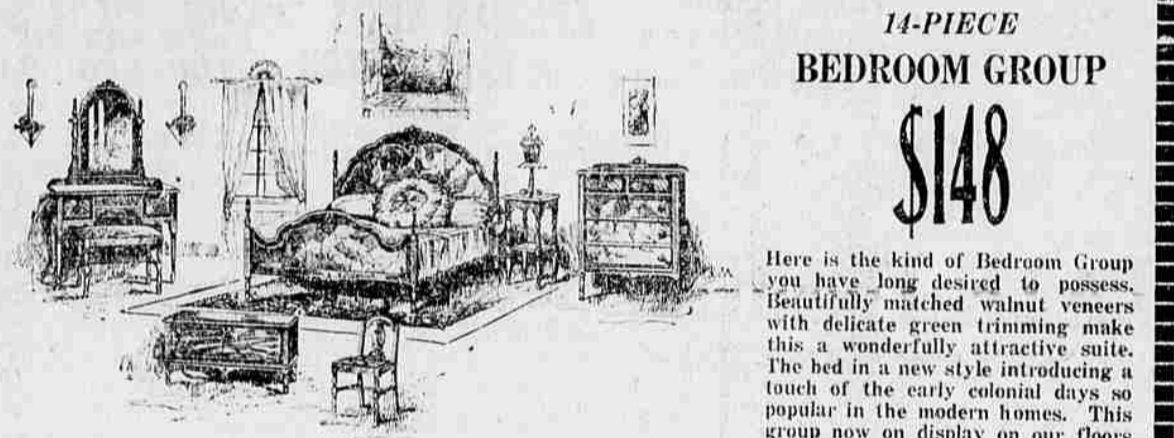

California And Washington To Meet on Apr. 5

SEATTLE, Wash., (AP)—Two great teams—Washington and California—will open the Pacific northwest track season this year with a night indoor dual most likely April 5.

It will be the second such event ever held in the northwest. Last year Stanford and Washington clashed in the Washington pavilion, with the Cardinals winning 75 to 55.

The evening indoor event made a big hit with the fans and much interest is manifested in the near-futuristic meeting.

Washington will pit a fancy band of athletes against the strong Bear combination, including two national champions, to rate the favorite, Steve Anderson, Husky captain, winner of the national collegiate and national A. A. U. high and low hurdles last year and Ed Genung, national collegiate half mile title holder, will show against the Bears.

The captains of the two teams will serve one of the most interesting of the events to the fans in the hurdles. At Fogsitt, leader of the California squad, intends to give Anderson his first big test this season. Despite an early season handicap of a sprained ankle last year, Fogsitt won third place in the Stanford-California meet and took fourth in the I. C. A. A. A. low hurdles in Philadelphia. His time was 22 2/5 seconds.

Everitt Mossman, red-headed two mile and Ken Churchill, 1925 captain and 200-foot javelin thrower, are two other stars of the California contingent.
