continuing policy of preservation and propagation. Game commissioners should be appointed without regard to politics. Public Service Commission Regulation of utilities is a public function. The state is the most powerful body created by the people. It is more powerful than the utilities which are created within it, and I am in favor of strengthening its power of regulation. I am opposed to the state giving up the power of regulation, because this means stepping backward into the past of unregulated competition and political corruption. Columbia River The Columbia river is waiting for the development of power, irrigation and commerce. These needs of the river must be utilized. Public or private investment must develop this water power resource.

to supply Oregon with electric energy capable of furnishing cheap power to new industries.

Education I believe our educational system stands high but must be made to rank among the highest in the nation. Its foundation is in our Normal schools. Its future depends upon a wise and liberal support of our state colleges and university. The board of higher education will continue to have my support.

Welfare Oregon has emerged from pioneer days into industrial expansion. It is headed for greater development. We must be prepared to meet an influx of people and the problems of congested population. An intelligent health, educational and welfare program will avoid the mistake of older communities. Our state and private agencies must cooperate to provide the best education and the highest standards of health, recreation and welfare laws. We face three major tragedies in our industrial civilization: one, the tragedy of unprotected childhood; the others the tragedies of old age and seasonal unemployment. We must endeavor to find a solution for all of these problems.

If elected, I will not be obligated to make any appointment in return for political support. I will make every appointment on the basis of merit. I will work for the greater development and welfare of Oregon. These things I shall take upon myself as a sacred duty and a solemn pledge to the people of the state.

Butter Market Top-Heavy; One Cent Reduction

PORTLAND, Ore., Apr. 3 (AP)—The butter market became top-heavy under accumulated supplies and advancing prices with the result that prices of all grades were reduced today at the Portland produce exchange. This decline brought extras back to 41c. Butterfat experienced a similar decline, the delivery price being 41c. Reviewing the fruit and vegetable market, the Portland bureau of the United States department of agriculture says: "The potato market continues active and stronger at most shipping districts, and at most terminal markets—with the exception of Portland. Local potatoes are in sufficient supply to make export trading very dull. Shipping point holdings at various Oregon points are estimated by Portland dealers as follows: Parakee, practically depleted; Deschutes 15 cars; Klama Falls 15 cars; Scappoose (seed stock) 25 cars. This does not represent total storage holdings in the state, however. "Asparagus is steady, following an increase in prices of California crop yesterday. Local rhubarb 5c week, with a slight decline from 4c per lb. Supplies are increasing. "Lettuce shipments of 231 cars on Monday mark the heaviest daily loadings of the entire year, and shipping point prices weakened slightly. Quality and prices of Portland's current supplies vary widely. Fair quality Imperial variety lettuce sells at \$2.00 to \$2.75, while good Arizona and Central California stock is as high as \$4.50 to \$4.75. "Although California strawberries have been present in limited volume for some time, first extensive volume of arrivals were seen yesterday. Quality is fairly good, but not fancy."
