**REGISTRATION
BOOKS CLOSE
ON APRIL 15**

county following the 1928 vote were reduced to 1,500 with those who did not vote being taken from the books. At present the registration appraisals 2,552, with a total of 33 persons registering this spring. Of the number registering this spring 15 were democrats and 18 were republicans.

Although a few of those who have registered this year may have been included in the revised 1928 figures, re-registering because of change of residence, or desire to change their party affiliation, with a rough estimate places the registered citizens in Union county at present as follows:

Republicans 2,392, democrats 1,500, total 3,892. Municipalities 27, municipalities 27. Individuals are being made made over the state that the vote this year will run 50 to 50 per cent, and if that were true the primary vote here this year would range between 2,000 to 2,500, which is a fairly heavy vote for an off-year primary election.

Persons who voted at the 1928 election and who have not changed their protest since then are entitled to vote without registering, provided they vote the same party that they did in 1928. Those desiring to change party alignments must re-register and those who have moved into another precinct must also re-register. Persons not voting in 1928 are also required to re-register.

Persons attaining county citizenship between Apr. 15 and May 15, may register now, and persons reaching the voting age between the same days, may also qualify to vote May 16 by registering at present.

Register Tomorrow Night

In order to accommodate those desiring to register but who are unable to leave their work during daytime hours, County Clerk McCormick will have his registration books at the police station tomorrow night from 7 o'clock on.

Persons Living in the Country

may register here and registers are also located in Union, Cove, North Powder, Elgin and Hamersville.
