Banking Change Since Year 1920

WASHINGTON, Apr. 15 (AP)—Asserting that the "good old days" in rural banking that prevailed up to 1920 have definitely ended, Lyman E. Wakefield, vice president of the First Bank Stock corporation of Minneapolis, yesterday described the initiation of a group banking system to reorganize the rural banking structure of the north-west.

Each of the Minneapolis institutions contains a group of almost one hundred individual banks, created through an exchange of stock between the unit banks and the holding companies. "By the creation of a group of wider diversification of risk and resources is accomplished than is possible in a single unit," Wakefield testified...
