

Radio Develops Special Bureau In Which To Build Its Programs

NEW YORK (AP) — Radio broadcasting has been responsible for many an allied art. Program building, its lifeblood, is one of these.

The making of radio programs has grown to the point where chain broadcast systems and individual stations have built up special organizations for this purpose. Besides there have been developed outside bureaus which make the program complete, ready to be taken to the studio and there transmitted for the listening audience.

The art, comparatively new, depends upon the showmanship of its various units as a highly important qualification, according to William H. Murray, president of the Judson program bureau, one of the pioneers in this field. This bureau builds many of the chain features heard nightly throughout the country.

"The growth of the program organization was a natural one," Mr. Murray said. "The nucleus was present in the organization of artists developed by concert management. Around them was built the system of specialists for program making, including conductors, production experts, writers, research librarians, arrangers and other specialists in music and drama.

"Today each radio period, whether it is for 15 minutes or an hour, is taken perfect to the studio, all prepared in advance by planning and rehearsal."

In pointing out the investment required, Mr. Murray said the musical library needed for radio work alone represented a value of more than a quarter of a million dollars. In addition there are maintained studios much like those of a broadcast station, where such artists as Josef Pasternack, Eugene Ormandy, Alois Havrilla and Lois Bennett, rehearse before they go to the station to put their programs on the air.

Everything is run to the second a stop-watch being an important item in making programs.

104 WOMEN ATTORNEYS SINCE BRITISH BAN ENDED

LONDON (AP) — During the eight years since the first woman became a member of the English bar, 104 of them have become lawyers.

Dr. Ivy Williams was the first admitted after the removal of the Sex Disqualifications Act in 1919 which extended feminine participation in the trades and professions.

Dr. Williams was admitted in 1922 and since that time there have been an average of 14 women a year called to the bar.

Very few of these women practice in the public courts, most of them contenting themselves with working in the privacy of law offices.

ANCIENT VALLEY OF GALILEE NOW HAVE MODERN HOSPITAL

NEW YORK (AP) — Mrs. Peter J. Schweitzer of New York has given an additional \$8000 for the Peter J. Schweitzer hospital, which will be opened May 1 in Tiberias in the valley of Galilee.

Her husband gave \$25,000 for the building of the hospital which will be the fifth modern one in

PALESTINE. It will be conducted by Hadassah, the women's Zionist organization of America.

The hospital will add a modern note to the ancient valley, still dominated by second century ruins. It will contain 33 beds and it is hoped will do much to combat disease. Tiberias, 700 feet below sea level, is extremely hot in summer.

PLAN 33-MILE BOULEVARD ON ISLAND OF MONTREAL

MONTREAL (AP) — Construction of a super-boulevard to stretch for 33 miles over the center of Montreal Island will be undertaken in the spring.

The highway will be 200 feet wide with two 40-foot traffic lanes. Two years will be required to finish it. The total estimated cost is \$8,000,000, of which \$4,500,000 will be borne by Montreal.

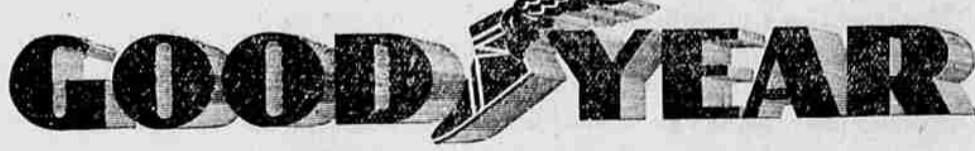
