ACHIEVEMENT

Meetings and findings of the American Chemical Society are important as well as interesting.

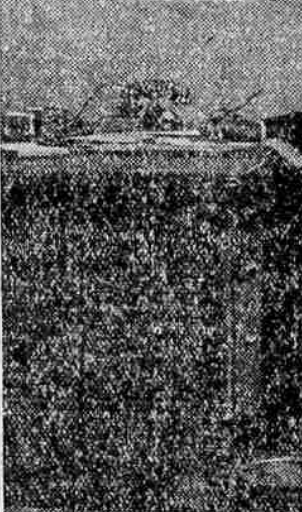
