Horse Racing Is In Comeback At Tanforan Track

By Russell J. Newland (Associated Press Sports Writer) SAN FRANCISCO, Cal., Apr. 23 (AP)—Horse racing, bolstered up and backed with an "option system," has come back with a couple of bangs at Tanforan track, the famous old byway a few miles south of here.

"In 1905, out of 10,000 persons down, which is nothing to sneeze at, have been registered at the plant during the 13-day meet. For the benefit of those who are not up on the subject betting on horse races has been illegal in California for many years. But officials of the Pacific Coast Breeders' association worked out a system whereby the law seems to have been satisfied, regardless of the fact that many individuals and organizations are not satisfied.

Briefly the option plan functions thusly: An individual selects a certain horse in a certain race and pays \$5 for an option to ride said horse if it wins the race.

If the horse wins the individual holding the ticket can either exercise his or her option to purchase the horse or sell the option back to the owner at whatever price the owner decides to redeem the tickets at. A test case in superior court was dismissed when the judge ruled that the evidence was insufficient to convict. The court also volunteered the information that the law undoubtedly was being violated but that there was a connecting link which the district attorney had not produced.

Whether or not horse racing has come back to stay, the fact remains that big crowds were noted every day.
