Issues Rebound Smartly In Wall Street Trading

NEW YORK, May 8 (AP)—Stock prices rebounded smartly on the stock exchange today, as bears were driven to cover in the copper shares, after a further selling movement which depressed United States Steel to a new low for the year. The rebound attracted renewed selling, however, and trading became dull, with price trends irregular.

The coppers were rushed up \$5 to more than \$5 a share, as bears, who had been expecting further reductions in the price of the red metal, rushed to cover their short commitments when it was reported the latest decline in the metal, taking it to 12 1/2 cents a pound was meeting with substantial buying from consumers both in the United States and abroad.

U. S. Steel, after selling off more than \$2 a share to a new 1930 low at \$165.75, attracted strong support and more than cancelled its loss.

J. I. Case dropped \$11 to \$367, then rebounded more than \$20, in response to unconfirming rumors that an early split up is in prospect.

The close was steady. Sales approximated 2,700,000 shares.

Operations Save Many

Rapid operations were performed to save the lives of many persons maimed by flying debris and almost wholesale burials were held for those found mangled by the crushing wind.

The death list has mounted slowly as additional victims succumbed to their injuries.

Farmers whose homes were spared made a house to house check, going on horseback and in wagons through flooded roads and fields. As a wrecked house was found, the bodies of the dead and injured were loaded into wagons and transported to the nearest town.

In north central Texas, near Waco and Hillsboro, similar relief measures were being undertaken. The death toll there having mounted to 12 near Hillsboro and 23 injured persons were in a Hillsboro hospital.

Egg And Butter Prices Appear Steadier Today

PORTLAND, Ore., May 8 (AP)—Egg and butter prices appeared steadier today than at any time in the last week. Receipts have been slightly less and demand apparently brisker.

Reviewing the fruit and vegetable situation, the Portland bureau of the department of agriculture says:

"Several cars of spinach are available for shipment, but eastern markets all report local spinach supplying the market in response to Oregon shippers' inquiries.

Cool weather is delaying maturity of Oregon head lettuce, so that first carlot shipments will not be loaded until next week.

"California strawberries show wide variation in quality. Itains at shipping districts have resulted in many soft water berries. Kennewick, is now expressing a few crates of strawberries daily, to north western markets.
