Music, art, athletics, manual training and domestic science all have valuable lessons to teach and on these grounds alone justify the time and expense they involve, he declares.

Menus Of The Day

MENU FOR DINNER
Ham Au Gratin Baked Potatoes
Biscuit Plum Jelly
Tomato Gelatin Salad
Orange Cream Cake Coffee

Ham Au Gratin, serving 6
5 tablespoons butter,
6 tablespoons flour,
3 cups milk,
1-2 teaspoon salt,
1-4 teaspoon celery salt,
1-4 teaspoon pepper,
1 tablespoon finely chopped onion.

1-2 cups diced, cooked ham,
2 hard cooked eggs, sliced,
1-2 cup cracker crumbs,
2 tablespoons butter, melted,
Melt 5 tablespoons of butter and add flour. Blend and add milk and cook until creamy sauce forms. Stir constantly. Add salt, celery salt, pepper, onions, ham and eggs. Pour into shallow, buttered baking dish and cover with crumbs, mixed with melted butter. Bake 25 minutes in moderate oven. Serve in dish in which baked.

Orange Cream Cake
1-3 cup fat,
2-3 cup sugar,
2-3 cup milk,
2 egg yolks,
1 teaspoon lemon extract,
1-4 teaspoon salt,
4 tablespoons grated orange rind,
2 cups flour,
2 teaspoons baking powder,
2 egg whites, stiffly beaten.
Cream fat and sugar. Add milk, egg yolks, lemon extract, salt, orange rind, flour and baking powder. Beat 3 minutes. Fold in egg whites, pour into 2 layer cake pans, fitted with waxed papers. Bake 25 minutes in moderately slow oven. Cool and add filling.

Orange Cream Filling
1-2 cup sugar,
3 tablespoons flour,
2 egg yolks,
1-8 teaspoon salt,
1-2 cup orange juice,
2 tablespoons grated orange rind,
1 tablespoon butter,
1-4 teaspoon lemon extract.
Blend sugar and flour. Add egg yolks, salt, orange juice, rind and butter. Cook slowly and stir constantly until filling becomes thick and creamy. Add lemon extract and beat one minute. Cool. Use as filling.

Frosting
2 cups sugar,
1 cup water,
2 egg whites, stiffly beaten,
1-2 teaspoon vanilla,
1-2 cup orange segments.
Mix sugar and water. Cook over moderate fire and without stirring, until thread forms, when portion is slowly poured from spoon. Pour slowly into egg whites. Beat until thick, creamy and cold. Add vanilla. Frost top and sides of cake. Arrange orange segments on top. Cut and serve with fork.

DAVIS PLEADS NOT GUILTY IN U. S. COURT

PORTLAND, May 7. (AP)—Emroy Davis, Umpqua national forest squatter, charged by the government with contempt of court because he continued to reside on his allegedly illegal claim after having been ordered off through court action, Tuesday pleaded not guilty to the contempt charge in federal court. He based his plea on grounds that he had maintained practically continuous residence since 1902, before congress passed an act reserving the forest land for homestead entry. Because of his prior residence, he does not believe he should be deprived of his forest home and thereby is not in contempt by continuing to live there, his plea sets forth.

When Federal Judge McNary told Davis his plea would be overruled, he asked for postponement or hearing until Friday. The request was granted.

Edwin Martin, another squatter charged with trespassing in the Umpqua forest, pleaded not guilty. Pleas of not guilty had previously been entered by J. E. Brahan and E. H. Best, two others arrested with Davis and Martin on contempt charges.

Federal officers said that on completion of the criminal cases against the four men, the government will bring civil suits against each to determine what their rights are in regard to residence in the forest area.

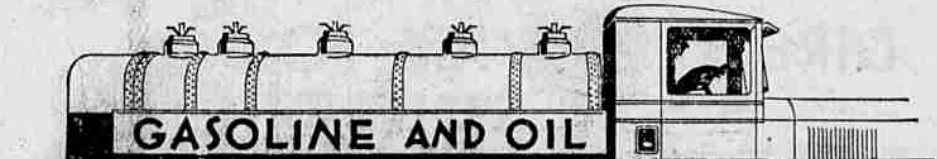

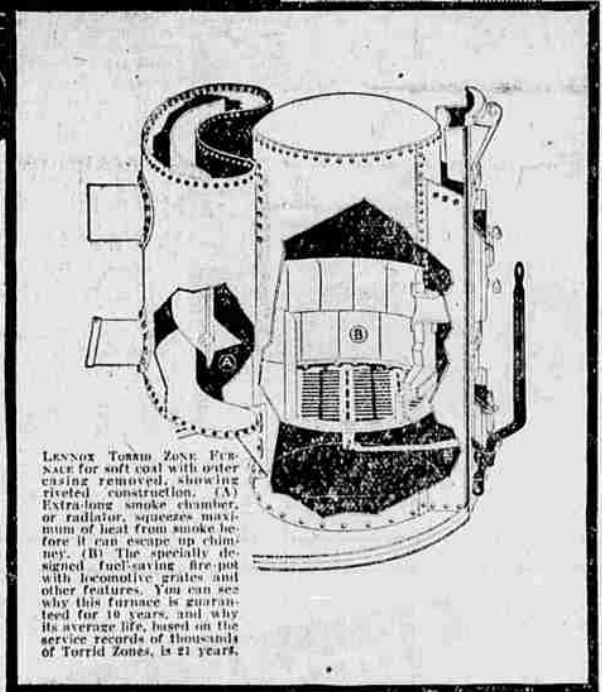
