Wild Horses Of Idaho Fed Here En Route West

Someday several months from now, a Frenchman may open a can of meat and find for his evening meal the flesh of wild horses caught in Idaho and shipped to a canning factory not far from Troutdale. In fact he may have been using meat shipped from this section of the United States for the past several years.

These horses are wild cayuses that run free in Idaho in lawless lands and often destroy property. They are caught and shipped on freight trains to Portland and as La Grande is a mid-point are let off at the stockyard for feed and water. Usually about two or three cars go through, but last Friday an unusual number of 16 cars stopped here.

At the factory the horses are slaughtered and used to make fertilizer, plus among other products and the better portions are canned to send to foreign countries where there is a market for horsemeat.

GRAIN MARKETS ARE UNSETTLED

Feed Grains Weak on Slow
Demand During Week—
Coast Wheat Weaker.

WASHINGTON, May 26 (AP)—Domestic wheat markets were unsettled during the week ending May 24 with the new crop making generally favorable progress and export demand continuing slow in spite of decreased offerings from the Southern Hemisphere, according to the weekly grain market review of the United States bureau of agricultural economics. Larger offerings, together with some slowing up in demand, weakened the corn market and oats and barley were slightly lower with this grain. Rye was featureless but weakened along with wheat. Flax declined sharply influenced by favorable prospects for the new crop and moderate offerings of Argentine grain.

New crop developments continue to be the dominant influence in the wheat market. Reports on the progress of the winter wheat crop of the United States were somewhat mixed but conditions are generally favorable except in some sections of the Ohio valley where the stand is thin and in the southwest where dry weather has done considerable damage. Spring wheat is doing well but growth has been retarded somewhat by cool nights. Canadian seedling is practically complete and germination has been regular in most areas. Shows improved conditions during the week but more rains would be helpful in some areas. Conditions in Europe continued generally good. Prospects are better than a year ago in most of the countries of Northwestern Europe but the outlook is slightly less favorable in Italy and France. The North African harvest is nearing completion and average yields are indicated.

Record Indian Crop
The 1930 Indian crop is placed at the record figure of 355,000,000 bushels according to the latest revised estimate. This compared with a harvest of 215,000,000 bushels last year and the preceding record crop of 372,000,000 bushels in 1923. The quality of the crop is reported to be good and characterizing about 1,500,000 bushels have been fixed for June shipment. Allowing for usual domestic requirements, around 4,000,000 to 5,000,000 bushels would be available for export, but because of the short crop during the two previous years and the tendency of growers to carry heavy winter stocks from seasons of large native supplies, export shipments may be below this amount.

Export demand for United States wheat continues dull and sales are still averaging much smaller than in a year ago notwithstanding the smaller Southern Hemisphere shipments which totaled only about 2,000,000 bushels during the week. Increased import duties in a number of European countries are no doubt, partially responsible for the smaller European takings of United States wheat. The French wheat tariff was increased from 25c to 35c per bushel effective May 21. The Spanish import duty was abolished but imports of wheat into Spain Balcara Islands are prohibited so long as the price of native wheat in any one month does not exceed \$1.75 per bushel. The Mexican tariff has been increased effective May 24. Other foreign wheat continued to come into actively with United States wheat in European markets. On May 23, 63 lb. Romate Argentina wheat arrived was quoted in London at \$1.17 1/2, while 42 lb. No. 2 hard winter for June shipment was offered at Liverpool at \$1.15 1/2 per bushel. No. 1 Manitoba for May shipment sold at London at \$1.27 1/2 and Western Australian wheat arrived at \$1.24 1/2 per bushel. French wheat was being offered in English markets at \$1.17 1/2 per bushel.

Wheat: Cash wheat in domestic markets was relatively weaker than futures with buyers more selective in their purchases. Offerings at Kansas City were in excess of current requirements on some days and prices declined slightly during the week.

Soft winter wheat markets were quite unsettled. Very little of this class wheat of milling quality is available but mills were making sufficient wheat for immediate needs and were awaiting the new crop harvesting which now promises to be up to two weeks earlier than last season.

Spring wheat markets were also easier with local receipts being supplemented by offerings from elevator stocks.

Coast Markets Weaker
Pacific coast markets weakened under the influence of lower prices at eastern points. Export demand in the Pacific northwest, however, was more active and around 1,750,000 bushels, mostly white wheat, was reported sold during the past two weeks. This week went principally to the United Kingdom. Stocks remaining in that area, however, are still large and domestic demand is not active. No new Oriental business has been obtained recently. The new crop is making favorable progress and some new white wheat for August delivery at

Portland has been contracted at \$1.02 per bushel. Sales of new wheat to date, however, are much below those of other recent years. Cash prices of old wheat declined in per bushel with No. 1 Big Bend Bluestem hard white quoted at Portland at \$1.17 and at Seattle at \$1.16 per bushel. No. 1 soft and western white wheats were quoted at Portland at \$1.04 and at Seattle at \$1.05 per bushel. No. 1 hard winter, northern spring and western red wheats were quoted at Portland at \$1.02 and at Seattle at \$1.05 per bushel. No. 1 dark northern spring wheat in bulk from Montana was quoted at Portland and Seattle at \$1.13 for 14 per cent protein and \$1.14 for 13 per cent protein. No. 1 dark hard winter at \$1.12 at Portland and \$1.10 at Seattle.
