Wheat Farmers Are Benefited By June Rains

PORTLAND, Ore., June 4 (AP)—West of the Cascade mountains and in the principal wheat growing counties in the northeastern portion the rainfall was sufficiently heavy to be of material benefit to vegetation, the United States department of agriculture's weekly report said today.

The crop report detail follows:

Cereals: All small grains in the northeastern counties and west of the Cascade mountains were benefited by the rains of the week. Winter wheat is heading well and is generally promising, but there is local complaint of thin stands, excessive weeding, and slight frost damage. The weather has been much too cool for corn.

Fruits: Ripening of strawberries has been delayed by cool weather, but berries are large and mostly of good quality. Cane fruits show much winterkilling in localities, but have been helped by frequent rains. A few early cherries are in market. Cooling moth control has been hampered by unusual temperature conditions. Thinning is in progress.

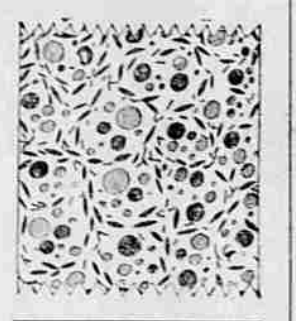

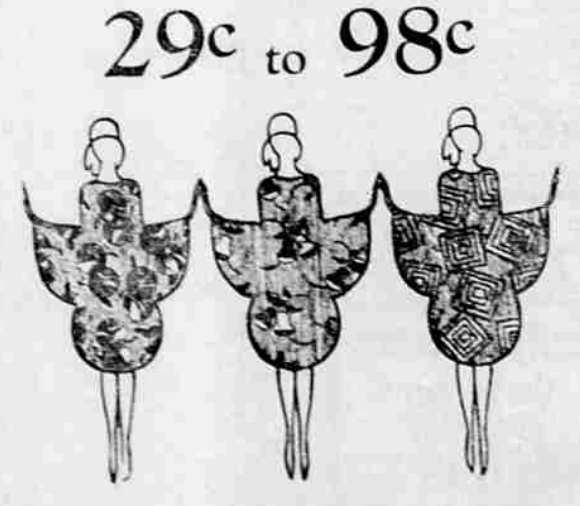

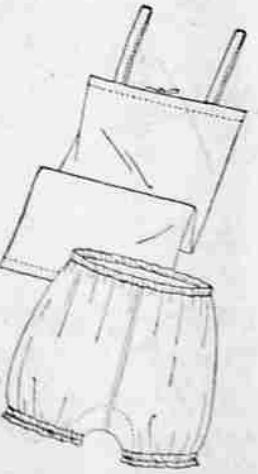
