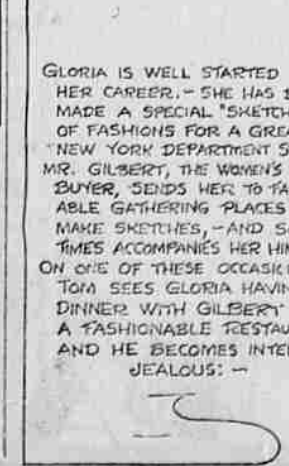

PORTLAND, Ore., June 9 (AP)—This will be opened here today on electric light installation in the Oregon Caves near Grants Pass. With the work of equipping the cavern with lights and one additional exit to be completed near the end of August, tourists will be able to see more of the underground wonders.

The work of washing mud from the caves followed installation of lights and a high pressure water system has been completed and has proven so successful that visitors can traverse the entire distance without fear of getting the clothing soiled.
