Elements in Vegetation

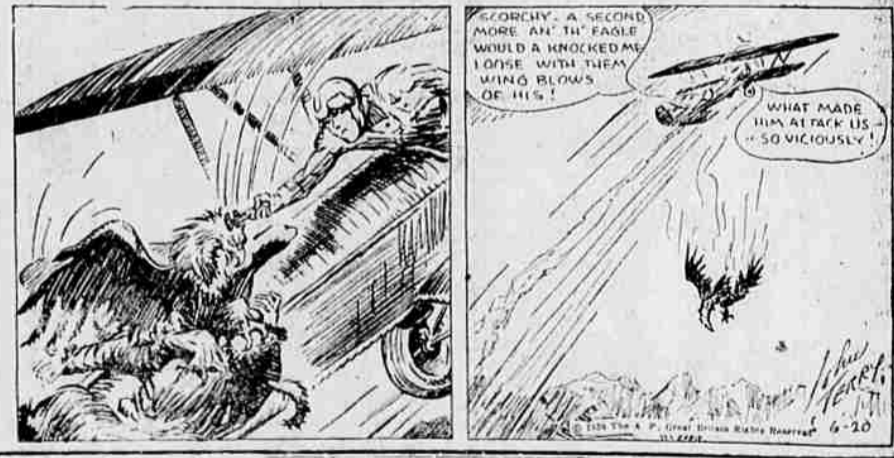
